To: Defendant Blue Water Capital, LLC., d/b/a Fleetsmarts

Defendant was served a summons and complaint on May 26, 2026, and proof of service was filed with the Court that same day. Pursuant to Rule 12(a)(1) of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, Defendant was to file an Answer within 21 days of service. The time in which to file an Answer has passed and Defendant Blue Water Capital, LLC, d.b.a. Fleetsmarts (Defendant) has not filed an Answer or otherwise responded. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 55, et. seq., of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, Judgment is to enter for Plaintiff on the counts of Breach of Contract, Unjust Enrichment, Interference with Economic Relations, Identify Theft, and

Communications Fraud. Plaintiff's claim for Preliminary Injunction is moot. Defendant is ordered to provide the following relief:

- Defendant is to execute a release letter allowing Plaintiff to use the services of any factoring company which thereby extinguishes any restrictions upon Plaintiff per the Uniform Commercial Code, and extinguishes any exclusive factoring arrangement or contract which Defendant may have with Plaintiff;
- As of the date of this Order, any existing contractual relationship between the parties is terminated;
- Damages to Plaintiff in the amount of \$31,571.63 for amounts charged greater than the 1.25% factoring rate;
- Pursuant to Utah Code § 78B-6-1701(1) and (2), damages equal to three times the amount of actual damages (\$94,714.89);
- Costs of service and of court, plus attorney fees, lost wages, and punitive damages (\$50,000.00) pursuant to Utah Code § 78B-6-1701, et. seq.;
- Post-judgment interest on the judgment amount at the rate prescribed by Utah Code Ann. §§ 15-1-1(2) and 15-1-4(3)(a), equaling 15.51 percent.
