Spousal support shall terminate earlier upon the death of either party or upon Respondent Taylor's remarriage or cohabitation as defined by Utah law.**

22. **Mattison Taylor's** alimony obligation will end the earliest of the following:

- **0** years and **4** months.
- If **Satori Taylor** dies.
- If **Satori Taylor** remarries.
- If **Satori Taylor** cohabits. Cohabitation must be proven in court before **Mattison Taylor** stops paying alimony.

Additional Provision: **PET OWNERSHIP AND CARE OF ASPEN.** The parties acknowledge that they jointly acquired a dog named Aspen during the marriage. The parties agree that Respondent Taylor shall be awarded sole ownership and sole custodial care of Aspen. Respondent Taylor shall be solely responsible for all costs associated with Aspen, including but not limited to veterinary care, pet insurance, food, grooming, training, boarding, and any other expenses related to Aspen's care. Petitioner Taylor shall be entitled to reasonable visitation with Aspen when such visitation is compatible with

Petitioner Taylor's work and travel schedule, subject to the following conditions: (i) Petitioner Taylor shall give Respondent Taylor at least one (1) day advance notice for any weekend or short-duration visitation; and (ii) Petitioner Taylor shall give Respondent Taylor at least thirty (30) days advance notice for any trip or extended visitation. If either party relocates outside the State of Utah, Aspen shall remain in the physical custody of Respondent Taylor in Utah and shall not be transported out of state by Petitioner Taylor. Respondent Taylor shall restore Aspen's pet insurance policy to Respondent Taylor's payment method within thirty (30) days of entry of the Decree.

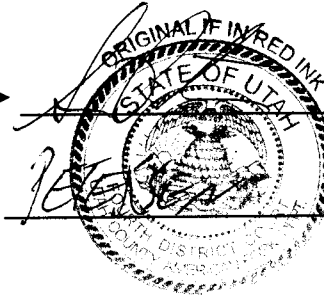
