The court decrees:

Divorce

1. Aquino J Guyton is granted a divorce based on the Declaration of Jurisdiction and Grounds signed by Aquino J Guyton. The divorce will become final upon entry of the divorce decree.

Duty to sign documents

8. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)

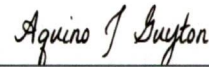
