2. Neither party is awarded alimony.

6. Petitioner is awarded as her separate property her home located at 191 North 900 East, Payson, Utah with Respondent being awarded as his separate property his residence located at 118 East 2nd Street, Marbleton, Wyoming.

7. The parties are each awarded their personal property as they have heretofore divided it.

8. All property and all property rights which may be vested in either party as a result of family inheritance, trusts, or similar sources are awarded to the party from whose family it came.

9. While the parties have no outstanding marital debts or obligations that were incurred prior to their date of separation being April 6, 2026, all debts and obligations contracted after said date by the either party is the sole responsibility of the party who incurred the particular debt.

10. Any and all pension, profit sharing or 401(k) plans are awarded to the party who is the owner thereof.

11. Petitioner is restored to her former last name of Floyd.

13. Each party is ordered to assume their own costs and attorney's fees incurred in prosecuting this action.
