Divorce

Additional Provision: **We have been in a long distance relationship from start.**

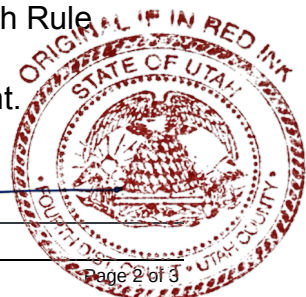
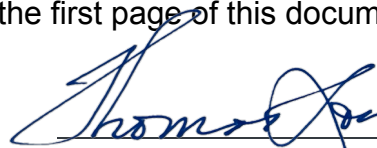
Duty to sign documents
