The above-entitled matter having come for trial before the Honorable Michael Edwards on March 11-12, 2026, the Plaintiff having presented evidence by way of witness testimony and exhibits, and the Defendant having presented evidence by witness testimony and exhibits. At the close of the evidence, the parties having rested, the Court instructed the jury on the law, and both sides argued the matter through counsel, and submitted the matter to the jury by way of special verdict. The special verdict was answered by the jury as follows:

Based upon the jury verdict herein, the Court being fully advised and for good cause appearing therefore, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. Judgment in favor of Julia Santos is entered in the amount of \$172,560.38, together

with pre-judgment interest until 4/1/26 in the amount of \$19,210.20 (through 12/31/25).

Pre-judgment interest shall accrue from 1/1/26 until the date of entry of judgment, at the daily rate of \$11.40. As of April 7, 2026, that amount pre-judgment interest is \$20,270.53.

2. Plaintiff is awarded costs in the amount of \$1,736.68.

3. The final judgment is \$127,076.77.

3. This judgment shall thereafter bear interest at the statutory rate of 5.51% until paid.
