This matter came before the Court pursuant to the *Verified Petition for Divorce and Parenting Plan*, the *Answer and Verified Counter Petition for Divorce*, and the parties' *Stipulation and Property Settlement Agreement* filed on April 21, 2026. The Court, having received and reviewed the *Stipulation and Property Settlement Agreement* and other papers on file in this matter, having entered *Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law* herewith, and otherwise being fully informed in the premises, for good cause appearing does hereby ORDER, ADJUDGE, and DECREE as follow:

1. **Jurisdiction.** Each party was a bona fide resident of Davis County, Utah for all of the 90 consecutive days immediately preceding the commencement of this divorce action. The parties' minor children lived in Utah for all of the six months immediately preceding the commencement of this divorce action. Jurisdiction and venue are proper in this Court.

2. **Divorce.** The parties are granted a divorce, hereby severing the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the parties, effective immediately upon entry of this Decree of Divorce. Immediately upon entry of this Decree of Divorce, the parties are hereby restored to their prior status as single, separate, unmarried persons.

3. **Grounds.** Divorce is granted on the grounds of irreconcilable differences.

4. **Marriage Information.** The parties were married on November 8, 2009 in Monroe County, State of Florida.

5. **Child Custody & Parent-Time.** The parties are hereby granted joint legal custody and joint physical custody of their minor children as detailed in the parenting plan found at paragraphs 3 – 8 of the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the terms and provisions of which shall be fully binding upon the parties, and to which the parties are hereby ordered to adhere and comply in full.

6. **Child Support.** Child support for the parties' minor children shall be paid as set forth in the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the terms and provisions of which shall be fully binding upon the parties, and to which the parties are hereby ordered to adhere and comply in full.

7. **Division of the Marital Estate.** The parties' marital estate (marital assets, retirement benefits, debts, and liabilities) is hereby divided between the parties as set forth in the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the terms and provisions of which shall be fully binding upon the parties, and to which the parties are hereby ordered to adhere and comply in full.

8. **Alimony.** Neither party is awarded alimony.

9. **Cooperation.** The parties are ordered to cooperate with each other and to perform in good faith all acts necessary to carry out the terms of their divorce settlement as set forth in the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. Each party shall sign and deliver to the other, in a timely manner, any and all documents reasonably necessary to carry out the terms of the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

10. **Miscellaneous.** All provisions set forth in the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are hereby made fully binding upon the parties, and to which the parties are hereby ordered to adhere and comply in full. All terms of the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law carry the full weight of a mandatory court order.

12. **Attorney Fees.** Each party is ordered to pay his or her own attorney fees and costs incurred herein through the date of entry of this Decree of Divorce.

13. **Final Order.** This Decree of Divorce is a final order, fully and finally resolving this divorce action.
