Petitioner, Michael Murphy, by and through counsel, David J Friel, has submitted all necessary documentation to enter this Decree of Divorce. Previously, the Court had entered Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law which were consistent with the Divorce Stipulation which both parties agreed to and signed. Therefore, the Court enters the following:

DECREE OF DIVORCE

1. Residency. Petitioner is a resident of Davis County, State of Utah, and has been for more than three (3) months immediately prior to the filing of the Petition in this

matter.

2. Marriage Information. Petitioner and Respondent are husband and wife having been married on September 3, 1981, in the City of Manti, County of Sanpete, State of Utah.

3. Grounds. Petitioner and Respondent have experienced irreconcilable differences which cannot be resolved. These irreconcilable differences have made it impossible for the marriage relationship to continue. Therefore, the marital contract is hereby dissolved and Petitioner is awarded a Decree of Divorce from the Respondent.

4. Minor Children. Petitioner and the Respondent are the parents of no minor children and none are expected.

5. Personal Property. It is ordered that the personal property should be divided as follows:

a. It is ordered that the parties' adult son, Sean Murphy, will come to the Mt. Pleasant Home and retrieve Michael's personal property within thirty (30) days of entry of the Decree of Divorce. It is ordered that Michael will not be allowed into the marital residence, however, he will be allowed to FaceTime with Sean while he is in the home to assist in Michael receiving his personal property. It is acknowledged that Mary has already boxed some of Michael's personal property and had Sean return them.

b. Should there be any disagreement regarding the division of any personal property, it is ordered that the parties should go to mediation for personal property only before initiating court action.

6. Real Property. It is ordered that Petitioner and Respondent may claim an interest in the following real property:

a. Home and real property located at 348 East 500 South, Mt. Pleasant, County of Sanpete, State of Utah.

7. As to any real property interest that either party may have in listed real property, it is ordered that Mary should be awarded all right, title and interest free of any claim by Michael.

8. Debts. The parties acquired debts during the marriage. It is ordered that each party should assume, indemnify, and hold the other harmless from liability on the

following debts:

9. Checking and Saving Accounts. It is ordered that the parties checking and savings accounts will be awarded as follows:

- a. Mary will be awarded her checking and savings accounts in her name: and,
- b. Michael will be awarded his checking and savings accounts in his name.

10. Select Specialties Loan. Mary is owed approximately \$28,635.00 from Select Specialties. It is ordered that Mary is awarded all of these proceeds free of any claim by Michael.

11. Retirement Accounts and Stocks. The parties have acquired an interest in the following retirement account(s):

a. Michael's 401K with approximate balance of \$3,801.60.

12. It is ordered that the retirement account will be awarded to Michael.

13. Taxes.

a. 2025. It is ordered that the parties will file their 2025 taxes jointly and use any refund to pay remaining back taxes. It is ordered that any refund remaining will be evenly divided. However, in the event that the 2025 refund is not enough to cover back taxes, it is ordered that Michael will be solely responsible for the taxes owed.

b. 2026. Beginning in 2026, it is ordered that the parties will file their taxes separately.

14. Alimony. Beginning February 1, 2026, it is ordered that Mary should be awarded alimony in the amount of \$1,450.00 per month. It is ordered that said alimony should continue until the Mary remarries, cohabits or for a period of twenty years (20) years whichever occurs first.

15. Attorney Fees. It is ordered that each party should be responsible for their own attorney fees and costs.
