I say the following:

5. There are no custody, child support, or parent-time cases about **Trinity Ann Henneman** and **Rowan James Emerson Henneman**'s minor children in any court or government agency. This includes filed, pending, and completed cases.

6. **Trinity Ann Henneman** and **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** have physical

custody of our child(ren), and are the only people who have custody, child support, and parent-time rights to our child(ren).

PARENTING PLAN

This Parenting Plan is being filed in good faith.
This parenting plan is agreed to by **Trinity Ann Henneman** and **Rowan James Emerson Henneman**.

Children - custody

(Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 9, Part 3)

7. It is in the children’s best interest that the parties be awarded Joint Legal Custody and that **Trinity Ann Henneman** be awarded Sole Physical custody. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** should have parent-time at reasonable times and places. **Trinity Ann Henneman** is filing this Parenting Plan and verifies the plan is filed in good faith.

Parent-time

8. The parents will follow a custom parent-time schedule:

The parents will follow a custom parent-time schedule.

- a. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman will have Meadow Ann Henneman every other weekend starting Saturday at 5:00pm and ending on Monday at 6:00pm. Whoever has Meadow the day of Christmas in 2026 will get her and switch off every year. Trinity Ann Henneman will have Meadow Ann Henneman every Thanksgiving. All other holidays will get no special treatment and follow basic parent time agreement.**

Parent-time for special occasions

9. The parents will follow the schedule for special occasions below. If there is more than one child and the children's school schedules vary for purpose of a holiday, at the option of the parent exercising the holiday or the parent's half of the holiday, the children may remain together for the holiday period beginning the first evening that all children's schools are let out for the holiday and ending the evening before any child returns to school. (Utah Code 81-9-302, 303).

Parent-time transfers

10. Pick-up and drop-off ("transfers") of the children for parent-time will be as described below:

The parties will make arrangements for pick up, delivery and return of the children prior to each scheduled parent-time.

Curbside transfers

11. There will not be curbside transfers. The parent/person dropping-off or picking-up a child may accompany the children to the other parent/person when parent-time transfers are made.

Decision-making

12. Each parent will make day-to-day decisions for the children during the time they are caring for the children. Either parent may make emergency decisions affecting the health or safety of the children. A parent who makes an emergency decision must share the decision with the other parent as soon as reasonably possible.

Joint decision-making. The parents will share responsibility for making major decisions about the children. If there is a disagreement, the parents will resolve the dispute as provided in the Resolving disputes section below.

Education plan

13. The school the children will attend is based on **Trinity Ann Henneman's** home residence.

14. Trinity Ann Henneman and Rowan James Emerson Henneman has authority to check the children out of school. Trinity Ann Henneman and Rowan James Emerson Henneman has access to the children during school. If the parents cannot agree, education decisions will be made by Trinity Ann Henneman.

Communication with each other

15. Parents will communicate with each other by any method.

Communication with the children

16. The parents agree they will:

- provide age-appropriate help to the children to communicate with the other parent.
- give the children privacy during their communication with the other parent. The parents will not interfere with or monitor communication between the children and the other parent.

17. Parents and children may communicate with each other whenever the children choose.

- By any method

Records and information sharing

18. Both parents will have access to records and the ability to consult with providers regarding education, child care, and health care.

Travel by the children

19. During their parent-time, the parent may consent for the children to travel with a sports team, religious group, school group, relatives, friends, by themselves, or with others.

20. If the children will be travelling for more than **3** days, the parent arranging the travel will notify the other parent at least **30** days in advance. That parent will give the other parent the travel schedule, locations and phone numbers at least **30** days in advance. In case of emergency, the parent will provide as much notice as possible.

Child care

21. A child care provider for our children must be:

A relative, friend, or neighbor.

Over the age of **21**.

Relocation of a parent (Utah Code 81-9-209)

22. If either parent moves more than 149 miles from the other, the moving parent must give the non-moving parent a written Notice of Relocation. The notice must be sent at least 60 days before the planned move.

a. The written Notice of Relocation must include:

- Information about the move;
- A proposed parent-time schedule; and
- A statement that the parents will not interfere with the other parent's parent-time.

b. If the moving parent does not give the non-moving parent a Notice of Relocation, the moving parent will be in contempt of the court's order.

23. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other, or if the parents live a different countries, parent-time will be as the parties agree. If they are unable to agree, the following will be the minimum parent-time for the noncustodial parent:

Relocation Schedule (Utah Code 81-9-209)

- a. in years ending in odd number, the minor children will spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent:
 - i. Thanksgiving holiday beginning Wednesday until Sunday; and
 - ii. spring break, if applicable, beginning the last day of school before the holiday until the day before school resumes;
- b. in years ending in an even number, the minor children will spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent:
 - i. the entire winter school break period; and
 - ii. the fall school break beginning the last day of school before the holiday until the day before school resumes; and
- c. extended parent-time equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the summer or off-track time for consecutive weeks. The children will be returned to the custodial home no later than seven days before school begins. This week will be counted when determining the amount of parent-time to be divided between the parents for the summer or off-track period. The parties will mutually agree on this extended time each year. If they are unable to agree, the noncustodial parent will select the dates for the extended time period.
- d. One weekend per month at the option and expense of the noncustodial parent. The noncustodial parent's monthly weekend entitlement is subject to the following restrictions.
 - i. If the noncustodial parent has not designated a specific weekend for parent-time, the noncustodial parent will receive the last weekend of each month unless a holiday assigned to the custodial parent falls on that particular weekend. If a holiday assigned to the custodial parent falls on the last weekend of the month, the noncustodial parent will be entitled to the next to the last weekend of the month.
 - ii. If a noncustodial parent's extended parent-time or parent-time over a holiday extends into or through the first weekend of the next month, that weekend will be considered the noncustodial parent's monthly weekend entitlement for that month.
 - iii. If a child is out of school for teacher development days or snow days after the children begin the school year, or other days not included in the list of holidays in Subsection (5) and those days are contiguous with the noncustodial parent's monthly weekend parent-time, those days will be included in the weekend parent-time.
- e. The custodial parent is entitled to all parent-time not specifically allocated to the noncustodial parent.

24. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other or the parents live in separate countries, costs for the children's travel expenses for parent-time will be shared equally.

25. If a parent has been found in contempt for not being current on all support obligations, and they do not have primary physical care of the child, they will be responsible for the child's related travel expenses.

26. Reimbursement for the child's travel expenses must be made within 30 days of receipt of documents detailing those expenses.

Resolving disputes

27. If the parents need to resolve a dispute regarding the children, they will discuss the issues in good faith and try to reach an agreement based on what is best for their children. If the parents are unable to agree, they will go to the following before bringing the issue to the court:

a. **Counseling**

Changing the plan

This plan remains in effect until changed. A change comes from a modification of a court order.

END OF PARENTING PLAN

Income: Petitioner (Trinity Ann Henneman) (Utah Code 81-6-203)

28. **Trinity Ann Henneman's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$0**. **Trinity Ann Henneman** base child support amount using the **sole** custody calculation is **\$304**. **Trinity Ann Henneman** receives the following gross monthly income:

29. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$0**. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman's** base child support amount using the **sole** custody calculation is **\$329**. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** receives the following gross monthly income:

30. The adjusted gross monthly income for **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** is **\$2366**.

Child support (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2)

31. It is in the best interest of the children that be ordered to pay child support to as follows:

a. **\$330.00** per month base support. This amount complies with the Utah Child Support Act.

32. Once a child is no longer eligible to receive child support, the support amount for the eligible children should be recalculated using the child support worksheet (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2). The parties may not divide the base child support award by the number of children and subtract that amount from the prior child support amount.

33. The **sole** custody worksheet was used to calculate child support.

Trinity Ann Henneman's base child support amount is **\$304** per month.

Rowan James Emerson Henneman's base child support amount is **\$329** per month.

If physical custody of a child changes from what the court orders:

- The parent owing support must pay the support amount to whomever has physical custody of the child.
- The parent must pay the support amount without asking the court to modify the child support order.
- This does not apply to temporary parent-time changes. (Utah Code 81-6-104(4) and 81-6-205(8)(a)).

Child support reduction for extended parent-time

34. If a child lives with the non-custodial parent by court order or written agreement of the parties for:

- 25 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 50% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(a)).
- 12 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 25% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(b)).

The custodial parent's normal parent-time and holiday parent-time do not count as an interruption of the consecutive day requirement.

35. If a child receives cash assistance through the T.A.N.F. or F.E.P. programs, any agreement by the parties to reduce child support during extended parent-time must be approved by the Office of Recovery Services.

36. The person ordered to receive child support can request mandatory income withholding (Utah Code 62A-11 parts 4 and 5). If support is past due, the State of Utah may take federal or state tax refunds or rebates and apply the amounts to the child support owed.

- a. Withheld income will be sent to the Office of Recovery Services (ORS) until all past-due support is paid. Child support payments will be sent to:
unless ORS gives notice that payments should be sent elsewhere.

37. If ORS begins mandatory income withholding, child support is due on the first day of each month and will be past due on the first day of the next month.

38. The issue of past-due child support may be decided by future court or administrative action.

39. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** will pay any ORS fees. If is the ORS applicant and the fees are withheld from payments to , will reimburse .

40. The parties must notify each other within 30 days of any change in their income.

41. The parties can ask to change this child support order by motion after three years from the date of its entry if:

- there is a difference of 10% or more between the amount previously ordered and the new amount of child support under the Utah child support guidelines,
- the difference is not temporary, and
- the amount previously ordered was not a deviation from the child support guidelines.

If the children receive TANF funds at the time an adjustment is sought, ORS will review the order and ask the court to adjust the amount if appropriate. (Utah Code 62A-11-

306.2).

42. The parties can ask to change this child support order at any time by petition if there has been a substantial change in circumstances because of material changes in:

- custody;
- the relative wealth or assets of the parties;
- income of a parent of 30% or more;
- the employment potential and ability of a parent to earn;
- the medical needs of the child; or
- the legal responsibilities of either parent for the support of others.

(Utah Code 81-6-202 and 81-6-212)

The change must result in a difference of 15% or more between the amount previously ordered and the new amount of child support under the Utah child support guidelines.

The difference may not be temporary.

The court can consider natural or adoptive children born after the entry of the decree other than those in common to both parties as part of a request to modify an existing award subject to limitations in the law. (Utah Code 81-6-202(8))

43. The Office of Recovery Services (<https://ors.utah.gov/>) provides services to individuals who are seeking assistance in the collection or enforcement of child support orders.

Dependent children for tax purposes

44. **Trinity Ann Henneman** may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes.

Child health care (Utah Code 81-6-208)

45. The parties must provide health care coverage for the medical expenses of the dependent children. Health care coverage means coverage under which medical services are provided to a dependent child through: fee for service, a health maintenance organization, a preferred provider organization, any other type of private health insurance, or public health care coverage. Utah Code 81-6-101(14),

46. **n/a** must maintain medical, hospital, and dental care insurance for the dependent children if it is available at reasonable cost. If medical insurance is not available at reasonable cost then both parents must ensure the children have health care coverage.

This may require applying for public health care coverage, such as CHIP or Medicaid.

a. If, at any time, a dependent child is covered by the medical, hospital, or dental insurance plans of both parents, the coverage will be as follows:

- **Rowan James Emerson Henneman's** insurance will be primary coverage.
- **Trinity Ann Henneman's** insurance will be secondary coverage.

b. If a parent remarries and that parent's dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a step-parent's plan, the

coverage will be as follows:

- **Rowan James Emerson Henneman's** spouse's insurance will be primary coverage.
 - **Trinity Ann Henneman's** spouse's insurance will be secondary coverage.
- c. Both parties will equally share the out-of-pocket costs of the insurance premiums.
 - d. Both parties will equally share all uninsured and unreimbursed medical and dental expenses that are reasonable and necessary. This includes deductibles, co-insurance, and co-payments paid by a party for the dependent children.
 - e. The party who pays health care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and payment within 30 days.
 - f. If a party does not follow this order and provide written verification, they may not be able to receive credit for health care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.
 - g. On or before January 2 of each year, the party ordered to maintain coverage must provide verification of coverage to the other party, and ORS, if they are involved.
 - h. If there is any change in coverage, within 30 days of the change the party ordered to maintain coverage must notify the other party and ORS, if they are involved.

Child care expenses (Utah Code 81-6-209)

47. Both parties will equally share all reasonable work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses.
 - a. The party who pays child care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and identity of the child care provider. This must be done when a provider is first hired, and any time the other party asks for the information. The party incurring or paying child care expenses must notify the other party of any change of a child care provider or monthly expense. This must be done within 30 calendar days of the change.
 - b. The party not directly paying for child care must pay their share of child care expenses as soon as they receive verification of the expenses.
 - c. If a party does **not** follow the order and provide written verification, they may not receive credit for work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.

Public assistance statement – Office of Recovery Services (ORS) (Utah Code 81-6-106(2)-(3))

48. Neither party has received or is receiving public assistance from the State of Utah.

Retirement money - military

57. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** will be a military member and entitled to receive or is currently receiving member's military retired pay (Uniformed Services Former Spouse Protection Act (USFSPA), 10 U.S.C. 1408). **Trinity Ann Henneman** is entitled to receive a portion of **his** military retired pay. **Trinity Ann Henneman** is **his** former spouse for purposes of division of the member's military retired pay under USFSPA. This court has jurisdiction over both the parties because: **Rowan James Emerson Henneman consents to this Court's jurisdiction. Rowan James Emerson Henneman's** rights under the Servicemembers' Civil Relief Act ((SCRA), 50 U.S.C. 3901 et Seq.) have been satisfied.

- a. **Trinity Ann Henneman** will be awarded **1%** of **Rowan James Emerson Henneman's** military retired pay.
- b. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** must give **Trinity Ann Henneman** a copy of any amended retired pay statement that **he** receives from a military finance center. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** must mail the copy no more than five days after **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** receives the amended statement.
- c. If **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** is recalled to active duty, **he** must notify **Trinity Ann Henneman** immediately. The notice must include information about the orders and reporting date.
- d. When a party dies, the rights created and the obligations imposed by this order end.
- e. The monthly payments in this order will be made to **Trinity Ann Henneman** regardless of **her** marital status and do not end if **she** remarries.
- f. **Trinity Ann Henneman** will apply for direct payment of **her** share of military retired pay in a timely manner. (10 U.S.C. 1408 and 32 C.F.R. 63)
- g. If **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** retires from military service and later also qualifies for a civilian retirement plan that allows **him** to combine **his** military and civilian service in order to receive a larger civilian pension, combining the pensions will not affect **Trinity Ann Henneman's** right to a monthly sum equal to **her** portion of the military retired pay as provided in this order.
- h. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** will indemnify **Trinity Ann Henneman** and pay **her** the difference between the amount awarded and any reduced amount that **Trinity Ann Henneman** subsequently receives if **Rowan James Emerson Henneman**:
 - waives any portion of **his** net disposable military retired pay in order to receive disability pay, or if
 - **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** takes any action which would defeat,

reduce or limit **Trinity Ann Henneman** collection of **her** portion of the military retired pay owed to **Trinity Ann Henneman** under this order.

i. **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** will pay **Trinity Ann Henneman** the difference between the amount of the direct payment from the finance center and the amount that **Trinity Ann Henneman** is entitled to under this order if:

- the finance center does not pay **Trinity Ann Henneman's** share directly to **her**, or

- the monthly payment to **Trinity Ann Henneman** does not equal the full award which **Trinity Ann Henneman** is entitled to in a given month under the terms of this order, or

- **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** has taken action to reduce, eliminate, or decrease **her** share in violation of this order.

j. **Trinity Ann Henneman** is the irrevocable beneficiary of the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) through **Rowan James Emerson Henneman's** military retirement.

- **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** will complete the paperwork needed to make or extend the election of **Trinity Ann Henneman** as beneficiary.

- **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** will do nothing to reduce or eliminate **Trinity Ann Henneman's** benefit.

- **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** will choose the “former spouse only” option and will choose the full amount of **his** retired pay as the base amount.

- The election will be made either within 60 days of the date of the entry of this order, or when **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** retires, whichever is allowed earlier by law. A copy of the election will be given to **Trinity Ann Henneman**.

- If **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** does not make the election, an amount equal to the present value of the SBP coverage for **Trinity Ann Henneman**, will become an obligation of **Rowan James Emerson Henneman's** estate when **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** dies. **Trinity Ann Henneman** will also be entitled to any legal remedies for violating this order.

k. Each party will notify the military finance center if there are changes in factual circumstances, modifications, or amendments to this order, or the results of other legal proceedings, that may affect the rights created and the obligations imposed by this order. The notice will be mailed to the military finance center by certified mail no later than 5 days after the occurrence of any of the events listed above.

l. This court retains jurisdiction to supervise, enforce, and modify the payment of **Rowan James Emerson Henneman's** military retired pay to **Trinity Ann Henneman**. The court may also amend this order as needed to ensure it qualifies and continues to qualify as a “court order” within the meaning of 10 U.S.C. 1408.

58. Once the divorce decree is entered, **Rowan James Emerson Henneman** must immediately prepare the appropriate Order for the Division of Military Retired Pay and submit it to the Defense Finance and Accounting Service along with Defense Department Form 2293. (Application for Former Spouse Payments from Retired Pay)

Additional provisions

59. The parties will adhere to the following additional provisions:

a.

Additional Provision: **THE PARENTS OF ROWAN JAMES EMERSON HENNEMAN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO WATCH MEADOW ANN HENNEMAN ALONE FOR OVER 2 HOURS. IF TRINITY ANN HENNEMAN OR ROWAN JAMES EMERSON HENNEMAN HAVE AN EMERGENCY WHILE MEADOW ANN HENNEMAN IS UNDER THEIR SUPERVISION, MEADOW IS ALLOWED TO HAVE OVERNIGHTS WITH THE SIGNIFICANT OTHER OF THE PARENT THAT IS CURRENTLY SUPERVISING MEADOW ANN HENNEMAN IF THE OTHER PARENT ALLOWS IT FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE RELATIONSHIP.**

Duty to sign documents

60. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)

Name after divorce

61. **Trinity Ann Henneman** changed **her** name when the parties married. **Trinity Ann Henneman's** name will be **Trinity Ann Archuleta** after the divorce.
