- 1. Dissolution of Marriage:** The bonds of matrimony existing between Petitioner and Respondent are hereby dissolved and the parties are granted a Decree of Divorce.

- 7. Name Restoration:** Petitioner's maiden name, Ross, is hereby restored if she so desires.
