**FINAL JUDGMENT FOR
DECLARATORY RELIEF**

The Court previously entered an Order of Declaratory Judgment on April 8, 2026. Accordingly, pursuant to Rule 58A of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court hereby enters final declaratory judgment in favor of Prime and against Rey Logistics, Inc. as follows:

1. Jurisdiction and venue are proper in this Court and county.

2. It is hereby Ordered, Adjudged, and Decreed:

a. There is no coverage under the Policy for the Rey claim because the claims-made and claims-reported requirements were not satisfied.

b. There is further no coverage under the Policy for the Rey claim because Mr. Miller was not engaged in Rey Logistics' Commercial Business Use.

c. There is no coverage under the Policy for claims or suit alleging negligent hiring or negligent supervision.

d. There is no coverage under the Policy for the return or restitution of legal fees, costs, or expenses.

e. There is no coverage under the Policy for mental or emotional injuries.

f. The May 17, 2023 incident did not arise from Rey Logistics' interstate motor carrier operations and therefore, Prime has no obligation to indemnify Rey Logistics in relation to the Rey claim or the May 17, 2023 incident.

g. As coverage is precluded under the Policy and no obligations are owed under the MCS-90 Endorsement, Prime has no obligation to defend or indemnify Rey Logistics or Mr. Miller in relation to the Rey claim.

h. As coverage is precluded under the Policy and no obligations are owned under the MCS-90 Endorsement, neither Rey Logistics nor Mr. Miller have any right of recovery against Prime in relation to the Rey claim.
