**DECREE OF DIVORCE**

This matter came before the Court for entry of a Default Judgment. The Petitioner, Bertha Lilia Soto Gonzalez, appeared *pro se*. The Respondent, Alexander Lopez Lopez, having been duly served with the Summons and Verified Petition for Divorce, has failed to answer or otherwise appear within the time allowed by law, and the default of the Respondent has been duly entered.

The Court, having reviewed the pleadings and files herein, including the Petitioner's Affidavit of Jurisdiction and Grounds for Divorce and the separately entered Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and being fully advised in the premises, finds that the Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this action and that the Petitioner is entitled to a Decree of Divorce.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:**

**ARTICLE I DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE**

The bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Petitioner, **Bertha Lilia Soto Gonzalez**, and the Respondent, **Alexander Lopez Lopez**, are hereby dissolved, and each party is restored to the status of a single, unmarried person.

**ARTICLE II GROUNDS FOR DIVORCE**

The Court finds that grounds for divorce exist as follows:

1. Irreconcilable differences have arisen between the parties, and the marriage is irretrievably broken, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated § 81-4-405(1)(h).
2. The Respondent has subjected the Petitioner to cruel and inhuman treatment, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated § 81-4-405(1)(g).

**ARTICLE III DIVISION OF PROPERTY**

The property of the parties is equitably divided as follows:

1. **Property Awarded to Petitioner:** Petitioner is awarded, as her sole and separate property, free and clear of any claim by the Respondent, the following personal property:
  - 2013 Range Rover
  - 2018 Jeep Cherokee
2. **Retirement Accounts:** Each party is awarded their own respective retirement accounts, 401(k) plans, IRAs, or pensions, free and clear of any claim by the other party.

3. **Joint Accounts:** Any and all joint bank accounts held by the parties are awarded to the Respondent. Petitioner shall take all necessary steps to remove her name from said accounts within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Decree.

4. **Real Property:** The parties own no real property.

#### **ARTICLE IV DIVISION OF DEBTS**

Each party shall be solely responsible for any and all debts, liabilities, and obligations incurred in their own name, and each shall hold the other harmless therefrom.

#### **ARTICLE V ALIMONY**

Both parties have waived any claim to alimony from the other, and the Court's jurisdiction to award alimony in the future is hereby terminated.

#### **ARTICLE VI RESTORATION OF NAME**

No request for restoration of a former name was made.

#### **ARTICLE VII MUTUAL NON-HARASSMENT**

Both parties are hereby restrained and enjoined from harassing, intimidating, threatening, or otherwise interfering with the peace and tranquility of the other party.

#### **ARTICLE VIII RETENTION OF JURISDICTION**

The Court shall retain jurisdiction over this matter to enforce the terms of this Decree.
