Defendant Easy Pay Auto Sales Inc. ("Easy Pay") having been serviced with process in this matter, has failed to appear, answer, or otherwise respond to Plaintiff Butler Capital Brokers, LLC ("Butler Capital")'s Complaint. The time allowed for responding has now expired and default of Easy Pay has been entered (*See Dkt. No. 24*). Now upon application of Plaintiff to this Court, default judgment is hereby entered against Easy Pay pursuant to the relief requested in the Complaint.

WHEREFORE it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that default judgment has been entered against Defendant **Easy Pay Auto Sales Inc.**, as follows:

1. Plaintiff Butler Capital Brokers LLC is awarded judgment against Defendant Easy Pay Auto Sales Inc. in the amount of **\$31,353.53**, (“Judgment”) representing the relief requested in the Complaint.
2. Post-judgment interest shall accrue on the Judgment pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 15-1-4, at the rate of 5.51%, compounding annually, until the Judgment is satisfied.
3. This Judgment shall have the same force and effect as any judgment of this Court and may be enforced accordingly.
4. The Court retains the authority to take measures to enforce this judgment in the event it is not timely paid.
