The above-entitled matter comes before the Court, the Honorable Judge Heather Brereton presiding. The Court, having entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, hereby orders as follows:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED

1. Petitioner is awarded a Decree of Annulment, declaring the marriage null and void *ab initio*, based on mutual mistake of fact.

CHILDREN

2. The parties do not have any children in common, and none are expected.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO BANK AND FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS

3. Each party shall be awarded the bank and financial accounts currently in their name.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO PENSION AND RETIREMENT ASSETS

4. Each party shall be awarded any and all retirement, 401K, IRA, or any other retirement-like plans, benefits, or accounts currently in their name.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY

5. The parties are not aware of any property. However, to the extent that either has an interest in real property, it remains separate and shall be awarded to the party whose person has an interest in the property.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO PERSONAL PROPERTY

6. The parties shall each be awarded the personal property currently in their control and possession.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO DEBT

7. Each party shall be responsible for the debt currently in their name.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO ALIMONY

8. Neither party shall be awarded alimony now or in the future.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO ATTORNEY'S FEES

9. Each party shall be responsible for their own attorney's fees, so long as this matter remains uncontested. In the event that Respondent contests the petition, he shall be responsible for Petitioner's attorney's fees.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO MUTUAL NON-HARASSMENT

10. The parties shall be restrained from harassing, harming, bothering, annoying, threatening, or committing violence against the other party.
