On October 21, 2025, the Court entered its Order On Hearing of October 1, 2025,
Regarding All Pending Motions and Granting Partial Summary Judgment to Plaintiff. Said Order
is hereafter referred to as the October 25th Order.

Thereafter, Defendants filed multiple motions for reconsideration, objections to the
October 25th Order, and many other objections and various other proposed alternative orders and
other actions, including to have the court allow Defendants to refile the defectively filed
counterclaim and cure the filing defects, and all other motions and objections (hereinafter

referred to as “Defendant’s Post-Order Actions”).

On March 11, 2026, the trial of the matters to be determined pursuant the court’s October 25th Order, came on and before the Honorable James Blanch, judge in the above-entitled court. Plaintiff’s witness appeared with its counsel, Stephen B. Elggren. Defendant Daniel Romero appeared pro se.

Defendant sought to have the Court reverse all or some of the court’s refusal to reverse the October 25th Order, as requested in the Post-Order Actions. The Court ruled that the motions and requests contained in Defendant’s Post-Order Actions were denied, except to the extent explicitly stated otherwise.

Thereafter, Plaintiff provided evidence and testimony. Defendant was allowed to question Plaintiff’s witness. Defendant was also permitted to present any evidence he desired to do. The Court also asked questions of the parties and received responses to the same.

Following the above, and the Court having fully considered the same, the Court made its Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law.

With good cause therefore appearing,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that judgment be and is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff against Defendants ALMA 3737 TRUCKING LLC and DANIEL THOMAS ROMERO, jointly and severally, for the following sums:
