Based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law entered by the Court, and for good cause appearing, the Court enters the following Decree of Divorce:

1. Petitioner is granted a Decree of Divorce on the grounds of irreconcilable differences and consistent with this Court's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and **Exhibit "A"** to the parties' Stipulation which are hereby fully incorporated herein by reference.
2. Neither party is awarded alimony and any claim for alimony is forever waived.
3. Full and final division of all marital assets and debts is ordered consistent with **Exhibit "A"** to the Stipulation on file at dkt. #31.
4. The parties shall timely cooperate to execute any necessary documents to transfer title to any property, asset, or debt awarded to a party.

5. Each party warrants to the other that they have made their best effort to make a complete, accurate, and current disclosure of all income, assets, and liabilities. Any deliberate failure to provide complete disclosure may constitute perjury. To the extent that it is later discovered that there was not a full disclosure, the party entitled to disclosure shall be awarded the sole ownership of any non-disclosed asset, and the non-disclosing party shall be responsible to assume, pay, and hold the party entitled to disclosure harmless from debt or obligation incurred, and shall pay the costs and fees associated with the non-disclosure of the asset.

6. Each party shall pay his/her own attorneys' fees and costs incurred in this action.

7. If any dispute arises between the parties regarding any provision in this Decree of Divorce and Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and Exhibit "A" to the Stipulation, incorporated herein, the parties shall participate in good faith in mediation with a mutually agreed upon mediator before seeking relief from the Court, sharing equally in the cost of mediation. A party that prevails in any enforcement or Court action shall be awarded his or her attorneys' fees and mediation costs.

8. Sara shall be restored to her maiden name of Thompson if she so desires.
