Pursuant to Rule 55(b)(1) of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court hereby enters Judgment in favor of Plaintiff ODK CAPITAL, LLC, against Defendants FIBERTEX CARPETING, CLEANING & RESTORATION, INC. and WAYNE BROCKMAN, jointly and severally, in the principal amount of \$61,229.56, plus pre-judgment interest at the statutory rate of 10% per annum, pursuant to Utah Code § 15-1-1, from August 28, 2025 through April 21, 2026 in the amount of \$3,958.95, attorneys fees in the amount of \$350.00, pursuant to URCP 73(f)(1), as the underlying agreement between the Parties provides for attorneys' fees in the event of default, and in compliance with Rule of Professional Conduct 5.4, for a total judgment

of \$65,538.51, plus post-judgment interest at the legal rate of 5.51% from the date of judgment until paid, based on the following:

1. Defendants FIBERTEX CARPETING, CLEANING & RESTORATION, INC. and WAYNE BROCKMAN have failed to appear or otherwise defend in this case;
2. Defendants have been served pursuant to Rule 4(d)(1).

It is further ordered that this judgment MAY be augmented in the amount of post-judgment interest at the legal rate of 5.51%, and reasonable costs and attorneys' fees expended in collecting said judgment by execution or otherwise as shall be established by affidavit, permitted by ruled and/or the law, and approved by the Court.

Defendants FIBERTEX CARPETING, CLEANING & RESTORATION, INC. and WAYNE BROCKMAN are jointly and severally liable for this judgment.
