The court decrees:

Divorce

Retirement money – retirement accounts



All retirement accounts held in Respondent's name will remain the sole and exclusive property of the Respondent, and the Petitioner waives all right, title, and interest, if any, in said accounts.

Duty to sign documents

3. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from the entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)
