The court decrees:

Divorce

1. **Anna Miller** is granted a divorce based on their Affidavit of Jurisdiction and Grounds. The divorce will become final upon entry of the divorce decree.

Three-month residency

2. **Anna Miller** and **Samuel B Miller** were residents of **Tooele, Utah** on the date this case was filed. **Anna Miller** and **Samuel B Miller** were residents for at least three months immediately before filing this case.

Marriage

3. **Anna Miller** and **Samuel B Miller** were married on **09/16/2000** in **Ogden, Utah**. We are currently married.

Grounds and divorce

4. **Anna Miller** asks for a divorce from **Samuel B Miller** on the grounds of irreconcilable differences. The irreconcilable differences are:
The marriage is irretrievably broken. Although we have attempted to solve our problems and make the marriage work, we have not been able to do so.
5. **Anna Miller** and **Samuel B Miller** separated on **10/29/2025**.

Children (Utah Code 78B-12-102(7))

6. **Anna Miller** and **Samuel B Miller** are the legal parents of the following children (Utah Code 78B-15-101 et seq.). This court has jurisdiction to make orders about these children.

a. KM Born: 10/30/2008

We do not have incapacitated adult children together who are eligible for child support, or, **Anna Miller** is not asking for child support for any adult child who is eligible for child support.

Children – Jurisdiction over custody and parent-time issues (Utah Code 78B-13-102(7), 201(1), and 208)

7. Utah has jurisdiction over the custody and parent-time issues in this case because:

- Utah is the home state of the parties' minor children under Utah Code 78B-13-102(7), or
- This case meets the criteria under Utah Code 78B-13-201(1), 207, and 208.

Children – Other court proceedings

(Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 100; Utah Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act, UCCJEA, Utah Code 78B-13-101 et seq.; Utah Uniform Interstate Family support Act, UIFSA, Utah Code 78B-14-101 et seq.)

9. I say the following:

- a. There are no custody, child support, or parent-time cases about **Anna Miller** and **Samuel B Miller's** minor children in any court or government agency. This includes filed, pending and completed cases.
- b. **Anna Miller** does not know of any criminal, delinquency, or protective order cases involving **Anna Miller**, **Samuel B Miller**, or their children.
- c. **Anna Miller** and **Samuel B Miller** have physical custody of KM, our child We are the only people who have custody, child support, and parent-time rights to this child

Children – Custody

1. It is in the children's best interest that Anna Miller be awarded Sole Legal Custody. It is also in the children's best interest that Anna Miller be awarded sole Physical Custody. Samuel B Miller Anna Miller is filing a separate Parenting Plan and verifies the plan is filed in good faith.
10. The children will live in Anna Miller's home 365 days per year and Samuel B Miller's home 0 days per year as the parties agree. Should the parties not agree, the children will live in Anna Miller's home no less than 225 overnights each year and in Samuel B Miller's Anna Miller is filing a separate Parenting Plan that details the plan and verifies the plan is in good faith.

Income – Anna Miller (Utah Code 78B-12-203)

11. Anna Miller's adjusted gross monthly income for child support purposes is \$5333. Anna Miller's base child support amount using the sole custody calculation is \$477.00 per month. They receive the following gross monthly income:
 - b. \$5,333.00 from the employer Tooele County School District, located at 92 S. Lodestone Way Tooele, UT 84074.

Income – Samuel B Miller (Utah Code 78B-12-203)

12. Samuel B Miller's adjusted gross monthly income for child support purposes is \$10800. Samuel B Miller's base child support amount using the sole custody calculation is 00.00 per month. They receive the following gross monthly income:
 - c. \$10800 from the employer CSE Hankin Environmental Systems, located at One Harvard Way, Suit 6, PO Box 5759, Hillsborough, NJ 08844. Other income earned monthly totals 100.00 from Respondent receives Per-diem of an undisclosed amount.

Child support (Utah Code 78B-12-202 et seq.)

13. It is in the best interest of the children that Samuel B Miller pay child support to Anna Miller as follows:
 - d. Monthly Amount of Child Support:
 - e. This is 477 per child.

14. Child support payments will start Dec 2025.

The payment schedule will be:

- one half by the 5th day of each month, and
- the other half by the 20th day of each month
- Child support not paid by the 5th day of the month is past due on the 6th day of the month. Child support not paid by the 20th day of the month is past due on the 21st day of the month.

If the Office of Recovery Services is used to collect support, their payment schedule will be followed.

15. The issue of past-due child support may be decided by future court or administrative action.
 16. The parties must notify each other within 30 days of any change in their income.
 17. The parties can ask to change this child support order by motion after three years from the date of its entry if:
 - there is a difference of 10% or more between the amount previously ordered and the new amount of child support under the Utah child support guidelines,
 - the difference is not temporary, and
 - the amount previously ordered was not a deviation from the child support guidelines.
- (Utah Code 78B-12-210(8)).
18. If the children receive TANF funds at the time an adjustment is sought, ORS will review the order and ask the court to adjust the amount if appropriate. (Utah Code 26b-9-211).
 19. The parties can ask to change this child support order at any time by petition if there has been a substantial change in circumstances because of material changes in:
 - custody;
 - the relative wealth or assets of the parties;
 - income of a parent of 30% or more;
 - the employment potential and ability of a parent to earn;
 - the medical needs of the child; or
 - the legal responsibilities of either parent for the support of others.

(Utah Code 78B-12-210(7) and (9)).

The change must result in a difference of 15% or more between the amount previously ordered and the new amount of child support under the Utah child support guidelines.
The difference may not be temporary.

The court can consider natural or adoptive children born after the entry of the decree other than those in common to both parties as part of a request to modify an existing award subject to limitations in the law. (Utah Code 78B-12-210(7)).

20. Child support for each minor child should terminate at the time and shall automatically adjust: (1) a child moves out of the home for school or at the age of 21, whichever comes sooner; or (2) a child dies, marries, or is emancipated (Utah Code 78A-6-801).
21. Once a child is no longer eligible to receive child support, the support amount for the eligible children should be recalculated using the child support worksheet (Utah Code 78B-12-202 et seq.)
22. Any change or modification to the child support order should only be made in accordance with terms set forth in Utah Code Ann. §78N-12-210(9).

Dependent children for tax purposes

23. Anna Miller may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes in even numbered years. Samuel B Miller may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes in odd numbered years.

Child health care (Utah Code 78B-12-212)

24. The parties must provide health care coverage for the medical expenses of the dependent children. Health care coverage means coverage under which medical services are provided to a dependent child through: fee for service, a health maintenance organization, a preferred provider organization, any other type of private health insurance, or public health care coverage.

Utah Code 78B-12-102(13).

Both parents must maintain medical, hospital, and dental care insurance for the dependent children if it is available at reasonable cost. If medical insurance is not available at reasonable cost then both parents must ensure the children have health care coverage. This may require applying for public health care coverage, such as CHIP or Medicaid.

- f. If, at any time, a dependent child is covered by the medical, hospital, or dental insurance plans of both parents, the coverage will be as follows:
 - Anna Miller's insurance will be primary coverage.
 - Samuel B Miller's insurance will be secondary coverage.
- g. If a parent remarries and that parent's dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a stepparent's plan, the coverage will be as follows:
 - Anna Miller's insurance will be primary coverage.
 - Samuel B Miller's insurance will be secondary coverage.
- h. Anna Miller will pay 40% and Samuel B Miller will pay % of the out-of-pocket costs of the insurance premiums.
- i. Anna Miller will pay 40% and Samuel B Miller will pay % of any uninsured and unreimbursed medical and dental expenses that are reasonable and necessary. This includes deductibles, co-insurance, and co-payments paid by a party for the dependent children.
- j. The party who pays health care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and payment within 30 days.
- k. If a party does not follow this order and provide written verification, they may not be able to receive credit for health care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.

- I. On or before January 2 of each year, the party ordered to maintain coverage must provide verification of coverage to the other party, and ORS, if they are involved.
- m. If there is any change in coverage, within 30 days of the change the party ordered to maintain coverage must notify the other party and ORS, if they are involved.

Public assistance statement – Office of Recovery Services (ORS)

25. Neither party has received or is receiving public assistance from the State of Utah.

The proceeds of the sale will be applied as follows:

Alimony

31. **Samuel B Miller** shall pay alimony to **Anna Miller** in the sum of \$3500 per month beginning Dec 2025. The alimony shall continue for a period of 120 months until Dec 2035.

Retirement money

32. **Anna Miller** and **Samuel B Miller** do not own, or have already divided, their marital retirement accounts, and will keep any retirement accounts that are in their own names or possession.

Duty to sign documents


33. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)

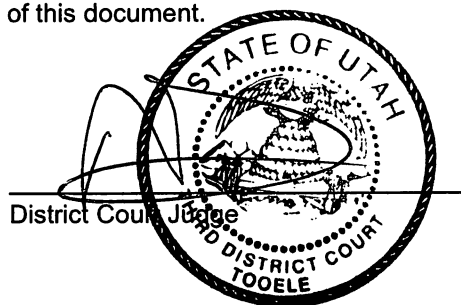
