Petitioner having filed a *Verified Petition for Decree of Divorce* against Respondent, having entered into a full agreement resolving all issues, and the Court having previously entered its written *Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law*,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED ADJUDGED  
AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS

1. **Jurisdiction.** The Petitioner has been for the three (3) months immediately prior to the filing of this action, a bona fide and actual resident of Salt Lake County, and the State of Utah.
2. **Marriage Statistics.** Petitioner and Respondent are wife and husband having been married on November 10, 2023, in Kearns, Salt Lake County, State of Utah.
3. **Grounds.** The parties have experienced irreconcilable differences, to the extent that the marriage relationship is no longer viable, and making it impossible to continue the marriage.
4. **Children.** There have been no minor children born as issue of the parties hereto, and none are expected.
5. **Real Property.** The parties each held interest in separate real

property prior to their marriage. The parties will each be awarded all right and interest in the real property owned or possessed by him or her at the time their marriage as their sole and separate property, subject to no claim by the other party.

6. **Personal Property.** During the course of the marriage, the parties have acquired interests in personal property which shall be divided as follows:

- a. **Separate Property.** Each shall be awarded as her or his sole and separate property all items of personal property that they enjoyed prior to the marriage, or which were separately gifted or inherited by each party during the marriage.
- b. **Personal Belongings.** The parties shall be awarded their own personal belongings and effects.
- c. **Marital Property.** The parties' household furniture, furnishings, fixtures, appliances and supplies, electronics and motor vehicles shall be awarded as presently divided between the parties.

1. **Debt.** The parties have no jointly-incurred or marital indebtedness. Each party is hereby ordered to assume and pay any and all indebtedness incurred in his or her own name, holding the other party harmless therefrom.

2. **Financial Accounts.** Each party shall be awarded any and all bank and financial accounts in his or her own name, subject to no claim by the other party.

3. **Retirement Accounts.** Each shall be awarded all right to and interest in any and all retirement accounts accrued in his or her own name, subject to no claim by the other party.

4. **Alimony.** Neither party shall be awarded alimony from the other.

5. **Attorney's fees.** The parties shall be ordered to assume and pay his or her own attorney's fees and costs incurred herein, as long as the matter is uncontested.
