DECREE OF DIVORCE

COMES NOW, Petitioner, MARIA PAULA GONCALVES DA SILVA ALMEIDA SANTOS (*hereinafter* "Wife"), having filed a *Petition for Divorce* and Respondent, EVERETT HENNING SIMONSEN (*hereinafter* "Husband"), having been properly served, the parties participated in good faith negotiations and having entered into a *Stipulation and Settlement Agreement* (*hereinafter* "Stipulation") resolving all issues in their divorce, and the Court having previously entered its written *Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law*,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED ADJUDGED

AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS

DIVORCE

1. **Divorce.** The bonds of matrimony heretofore existing by and between MARIA PAULA GONCALVES DA SILVA ALMEIDA SANTOS and EVERETT HENNING SIMONSEN are hereby dissolved, and the parties are granted a Decree of Divorce, to become final upon entry by the Court.

2. **Children.** The parties do not have any children and none are expected.

DIVISION OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES

3. **Separate and Premarital Property.** Each party is awarded their separate and premarital property, including property or monies in their possession at the time of marriage or received from inheritance, unless stated otherwise herein.

4. **Personal Property.** During the course of the parties' marriage, the parties acquired certain items of personal property, which shall be divided equitably as the parties agree.

5. Wife has several boxes of personal items in Husband's garage. She shall arrange and pay for transport/shipping of these items within 14 days of the Stipulation. Husband shall cooperate with the transport as arranged.

6. **Vehicles.** Each party is awarded the vehicle in their possession. Each party shall be solely responsible for any maintenance, payments, or loans on the vehicle they are awarded.

7. **Accounts.** The parties have acquired certain bank and financial accounts. Each party shall retain their respective accounts free and clear of any claim from the other.

8. **Debts and Obligations.** During the course of the marriage, the parties have acquired certain debts, which shall be divided as follows:

a. Each party shall be responsible for any debts incurred in their own name and shall indemnify and hold the other party harmless for the same.

9. The parties shall be restrained from incurring any debt or obligation on any joint account and on any account in the name of the other party.

10. Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 81-4-406(3)(b), the parties shall notify respective creditors or obliges regarding division of debts, obligations, or liabilities herein and the parties' separate and current address.

11. **Retirement and Other Investment Accounts.** Each party shall keep any retirement accounts in their own name free and clear of any claim of the other.

12. **Real Property.** The parties have not acquired any real property.

13. **Business Interests.** During the course of the marriage, the parties have not acquired any business interests.

14. **Alimony.** The marriage was of short duration. Neither party shall be awarded alimony.

15. **Family Pet(s).** Wife shall be awarded sole ownership and custody of the dog "Bucky."

a. Bucky is currently in Florida. Wife shall arrange and pay for the transport of Bucky. Husband shall release Bucky within 14 days of the Stipulation, or as otherwise agreed by the parties. He shall also send Wife the dog's veterinary records and proof of vaccination within 7 days.

b. Should Wife ever relocate outside of the United States involuntarily or is unable to care for Bucky, Bucky's ownership shall immediately revert to Husband.

- i. Wife shall provide Husband with written notice at least fourteen (14) days prior to any involuntary relocation outside the United States. Upon transfer of ownership to Husband, Wife shall execute any documents necessary to effectuate the transfer of ownership.
- c. Should Wife decide to sell Bucky or give up his care, Husband is granted the first option to purchase and shall acquire full ownership of Bucky for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00). Wife shall not sell, gift, or otherwise transfer ownership of Bucky to any third party without first offering Husband the opportunity to acquire Bucky pursuant to the Stipulation.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

16. Mutual Restraining Orders. The parties are subject to the following Mutual Restraining Order:

- a. Both parties are mutually restrained from harassing, annoying, swearing at, demeaning, or otherwise bothering the other party in person or online. Should the parties need to communicate, communication should be respectful.
- b. Neither party shall enter the residence and/or work location of the other party unless they are invited to do so.

17. Attorney's Fees. Each party shall pay their own attorney's fees.

18. Civil Obligations. Wife releases Husband from any and all civil obligations incurred by Husband's I-864 Affidavit of Support.

- a. Husband shall not take affirmative action with the specific intent to interfere with or terminate Wife's lawful immigration status, except that nothing

in this agreement shall prevent Husband from pursuing withdrawal of any immigration provision (I-130, I-864 Affidavit of Support) through proper USCIS procedures, including responding to any requests for evidence of information from USCIS.
