In this matter, Defendant Kriangsak Tudsandos (“Defendant”) has been served with process and having failed to appear and answer plaintiff’s complaint on file herein, the time allowed by law having expired, and the Court having previously entered the default of the defendants, now upon the application of plaintiff to this Court, and good cause appearing therefore, It Is Hereby Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed as follows:

1. Plaintiff’s Motion for Entry of Default Judgment is hereby GRANTED.
2. Plaintiff is awarded a money judgment against Defendant in the amount of \$28,606.80, as of August 27, 2024, plus all accruing interest under the Agreement.
3. Plaintiff is awarded possession of the Collateral consisting of a vehicle identified as a 2022 FLHXS Street Glide Special, having VIN number 1HD1KRP1XNB611861 (the “Collateral”).

4. Defendant is hereby ordered to surrender the Collateral to plaintiff.

5. Plaintiff shall be issued writs of replevin and assistance by which plaintiff may take possession of and recover the Collateral from defendant(s) or any other person or entity who may be currently in possession of the Collateral, and any proceeds resulting from the sale or execution thereof or thereon shall be applied to the balance of the judgment recovered herein.

6. Plaintiff may augment the judgment in the amount of reasonable costs and attorney's fees expended in collecting and enforcing the judgment by execution or otherwise established by affidavit from plaintiff's counsel and subject to court approval or by court order.
