NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS  
FOLLOWS:

1. That the Plaintiff be awarded judgment against the Defendant for the sum of \$14287.36 which is inclusive of \$13512.36 in principal, \$425.00 in court cost and \$350.00 in attorney's fees; as prayed for in the complaint.
2. The Defendant is to pay \$250.00 per month commencing May 20, 2026, and by the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month thereafter until paid in full.
3. That Plaintiff agrees to forego executing on post judgment remedies as long as the defendant makes the payments when due.
