The court decrees:

Divorce

1. Tina Lee L'HOTE is granted a divorce based on the Affidavit of Jurisdiction of Grounds. The divorce will become final upon entry of the divorce decree.

Children (Utah Code 78B-12-102(7))

Tina Lee L'HOTE and John Nickolas L'Hote do not have any children together. They do not have any children together who are minors. They are not expecting a child. They do not have incapacitated adult children together who are eligible for child support, nor, are they asking for child support for any adult child who is eligible for child support.

Personal Property (Utah Code 30-3-5)

2. All personal property not addressed in the divorce should be divided as the parties have already divided it.

Debts

The parties are not aware of any debts from the marriage. If any debts exist, each debt will be the responsibility of the party who incurred the debt.

Real Property

The parties do not have any real property that is marital property. The parties do not need a court order about real property.

Alimony

Neither party will pay alimony.

Retirement money

3. The parties have no interest in any retirement money which is marital property, and do not need a court order about retirement money.

Name after divorce

4. Petitioner changed his/her name when the parties married. Petitioner's name will be restored to Tina Lee Bates after the divorce.

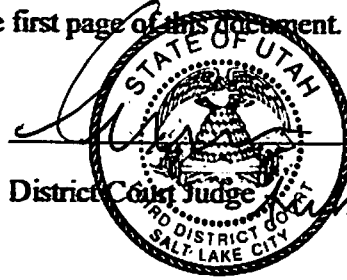
Duty to sign documents

5. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from the entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)


