DECREE OF DIVORCE

This matter having come before the Court, and the Court having reviewed the Verified Petition for Divorce, the signed Settlement Agreement between the parties, and having entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Dissolution of Marriage: The bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between Petitioner, Michael Dale Milne, and Respondent, Eldineide Ribeiro de Souza, are hereby dissolved, and the parties are granted an absolute decree of divorce based upon irreconcilable differences. The parties are restored to the status of single, unmarried persons.

2. Minor Children: The Court finds that there are no minor children born to or adopted by the parties during the marriage, and no children are expected. Therefore, no orders regarding child custody, parent-time, or child support are entered.

3. Alimony: Neither party requested alimony, and pursuant to the Settlement Agreement waiving remaining financial claims, neither party is awarded alimony.

4. Property and Debts: The parties' property and debts are distributed and resolved pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement signed by the parties on May 12, 2026. Pursuant to that agreement, Respondent has waived all remaining financial claims related to this divorce proceeding,

and the parties shall have no further financial disputes in this matter. The Settlement Agreement is incorporated herein by reference and made an enforceable order of this Court.


5. Preservation of Rights: As stipulated in the Settlement Agreement, this resolution is limited exclusively to the financial issues in this divorce proceeding. This Decree does not alter, invalidate, or modify any previously existing facts, reports, safety concerns, communications with authorities, or separate proceedings between the parties.

6. Non-Interference: The parties are mutually ordered not to interfere in each other's personal lives following the entry of this Decree of Divorce.

7. Finality: This Decree of Divorce constitutes a final order and resolves all remaining issues pending before this Court in this matter.
