IN THIS ACTION, Defendant Linda Taylor ("**Taylor**"), having been regularly served with process and having failed to appear and answer Plaintiff Friendship Manor Corporation's ("**Plaintiff**" or "**Friendship Manor**") Verified Complaint filed herein, the legal time for answering having expired, and the default of Taylor in the premises having been duly entered according to law, now upon the application of said Plaintiff, judgment is hereby entered against said Defendant Taylor in accordance with the prayer of said complaint.

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the law, and by reason of the premises aforesaid,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff shall have judgment against Defendant Linda Taylor in the amount \$648.00, as of March 31, 2026, plus additional amounts which accrue under the Lease until Defendant moves out, including continuing rent, late fees and other charges, plus interest thereon provided under the Lease until paid, and for three times the amount of damages as provided for in Utah Code Ann. § 78B-6-811, together with Plaintiff's attorney's fees and costs incurred herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that pursuant to Utah Code §38-3-1 et seq. Plaintiff is entitled to the attachment of all non-exempt personal property of Defendant Taylor which is in or upon the leased premises located at 1320 E 500 S, Unit 1004, Salt Lake City, UT 84102 (the "**Property**"), and for an order of this Court that such Property is to be disposed of in accordance with applicable law to satisfy the amount of charges due and owing;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant is in unlawful detainer of the Property. Plaintiff is entitled to immediate possession of the Property and an Order of Restitution shall issue forthwith from this Court directing a sheriff or constable of Salt Lake County to take possession of the Property and to deliver possession of the same to Plaintiff.

THIS JUDGMENT MAY BE AUGMENTED IN THE AMOUNT OF REASONABLE COSTS AND ATTORNEYS' FEES EXPENDED IN COLLECTION SAID JUDGMENT BY EXECUTION OR OTHERWISE AS SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY AFFIDAVIT.
