The Plaintiff was represented by, G Scott Jensen of the law firm of JENSEN & SULLIVAN LLC.; the Defendant was present, but not represented by counsel; the Court strikes the Defendant's pleadings; the parties having entered into a stipulation in open Court and the Court having approved said stipulation:

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS
FOLLOWS:

1. That the Plaintiff be awarded judgment against the Defendant for the sum of \$5000.00 which is inclusive of \$3400.00 in principal, \$1122.00 in collection fees, \$230.00 in court cost and \$248.00 in attorney's fees; as prayed for in the complaint.
2. That interest on the total at the rate of 13.51% per annum pursuant to Section 15-1-4 U.C.A. from the date of this judgment until paid.
3. The defendant is to pay \$100.00 per month commencing May 20, 2026, and by the 20th of each month thereafter for six months. Defendant is to contract the Plaintiff by October 20, 2026, to arrange for a new payment amount.
4. The Plaintiff agreed to forego executing on post judgment remedies as long as the defend makes the payments when due.
