This matter came before the Court following the submission to the Court of a written stipulation which resolved all pending issues. The Court, having examined the file and the contents therein and deeming itself to be fully informed in the premises and having issued Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, now issues and Orders as follows:

DECREE OF DIVORCE

1. The bonds of matrimony heretofore existing by and between the Petitioner and Respondent are hereby dissolved, and the parties are hereby awarded a Decree of Divorce to become absolute and final upon entry by the Court.
2. The parties shall be granted a divorce on the grounds of irreconcilable differences, because the parties have been unable to resolve their marital problems, making continuation of their marriage impossible.
3. Children. The parties have no minor children, and none are expected.
4. Personal Property. Any and all personal property acquired during the parties' marriage shall be equitably divided between the parties. Each party should be awarded his/her premarital property, if any so exists. Any vehicles acquired during the parties' marriage should be awarded to the party who is in possession of the vehicle and that party should be solely responsible for any debt thereon.
5. Real Property. The parties did not acquire any real property during their marriage.
6. Premarital or Separate Assets: Each party shall be awarded any premarital assets in his/her name. Each party shall be awarded any separate assets held in his/her name including separate property, gifts and/or inheritance. Respondent shall be awarded his Robinhood account, including any growth that has occurred in the account during the marriage.
7. Marital Assets: In consideration of the division of marital assets the Respondent

shall be awarded and receive a one-time payment of \$25,000.00 from the Petitioner, as well as the conveyance of the full right title and interest in Chery Bomb Games, LLC, filed in Washington State: EIN#99-1708881 | UBI: 605 443 066.

8. Retirement Accounts: If either party acquired a 401-K or retirement account during marriage it shall be awarded to the party in whose name the account is presently held.

9. Alimony. Each party is gainfully employed and is fully capable of supporting him/herself. Each party is and has been living separately. Therefore, there shall be no award of alimony to either party.

10. Debts. The parties have no shared marital debts. If any debts are later discovered, they shall be the sole responsibility of the party in whose name they're in.

11. The Petitioner may be restored to her former surname of Makayla Millard, should she so desire.

12. Attorney's Fees. Each party shall pay for his/her own attorney fees if any were so incurred.
