This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff's motion for entry of default judgment against Defendant Bernardo Saucedo Valles and Defendant Telluride Stone and Masonry, Inc. The Court held an evidentiary hearing on May 11, 2026.

Upon review of the record and being fully advised in the premises and for good cause appearing, the Court hereby enters default judgment pursuant to Utah Rules of Civil Procedure 54 and 55(b)(2), in favor of plaintiff Elidio Oliva and against defendant Bernardo Saucedo Valles and defendant Telluride Stone and Masonry, Inc. Therefore, it is hereby ordered, adjudged, and decreed:

1. Judgment is entered in favor of plaintiff Elidio Oliva and against defendants Bernardo Saucedo Valles and Defendant Telluride Stone and Masonry, Inc.
2. Plaintiff is awarded damages of \$121,283.32, comprised of \$31,879.03 for past economic damages, \$9,404.29 for pre-judgment interest, and \$80,000.00 for non-economic damages.
3. Total judgment amount is **\$121,283.32** in favor of Plaintiff Oliva and against defendant Saucedo Valles and defendant Telluride, jointly and severally.
4. Post-judgment interest shall accrue at the statutory judgment rate on the total unpaid judgment amount from the date of entry of judgment until paid in full.
5. This judgment constitutes a final judgment pursuant to Utah. R. Civ. P 54 and 58A.
