NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED ADJUDGED AND
DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Plaintiff be awarded judgment against the Defendant for the sum of \$9303.84; which is inclusive of \$8723.84 in principal, \$230.00 in court cost and \$350.00 in attorney's fees; as prayed for in the complaint.
2. That judgment shall bear interest at 5.51% on the first cause of action, which was not an action for the purchase of goods and services, principal amount of \$8182.14, plus \$350 attorney fees, and 18% on the second cause of action, principal amount of \$541.70 as set forth in the contract.
