The above-captioned matter having come before the above-referenced Court, the Court having reviewed the file and finding the necessary pleadings in the file, the Court having entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and being otherwise fully advised states:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

Provisions Relating to Termination of Marriage

1. Danielle is an actual and bonafide resident of Salt Lake County, State of Utah, and has been for more than three months immediately prior to the commencement of this action.

2. Danielle is awarded a divorce from Jacob on the grounds of irreconcilable differences and the marriage is hereby terminated.

Provisions Relating to Minor Children

3. The parties have no minor children and none are expected.

Provisions Relating to Alimony

4. Neither party is in need of any alimony therefore it is waived now and forever in the future.

Provisions Relating to Real Property

5. The parties acquired real property located at 685 W. 2250 N., West Bountiful, UT 84087.
 - a. The real property was sold and the parties already divided the proceeds.

Provisions Relating to Personal Property

6. Each party is awarded their own separate personal property that they acquired before their marriage.
7. Danielle is awarded the 2024 Toyota Rav-4 and any debt associated with this vehicle.
 - a. Danielle is awarded the proceeds from the sale of the 2016 Nissan Sentra which has already been sold.
8. Jacob does not currently have a vehicle. If a vehicle is discovered in his name it is awarded to him free and clear of any claim by Danielle.
9. All other personal property acquired during the marriage is divided as the parties have already divided it.

- a. Jacob's property is currently in a storage unit and he is awarded the contents of the unit free and clear.

Provisions Relating to Financial/Bank Accounts

10. The parties agree that the marital account at Discover Bank is awarded to Danielle. Danielle agrees to close this account after properly transferring the funds in this account to another bank. The discover bank account has a savings and a checking both of which is awarded to Danielle.
11. All other accounts are awarded to the person who's name is on the account free and clear of any claim by the other party.

Provisions Relating to Investment Accounts and Retirement Accounts

12. The parties shall keep their retirement accounts in their own names and waive claim to the retirement of the other party.
13. An E-Trade account was established by Danielle on behalf of Jacob. When Jacob is able, he shall get these funds solely into his name. Danielle shall have no claim to these funds or their gains while in this investment account. The funds in this account are Jacob's from the sale of the marital residence.

Provisions Relating to Debts

14. The parties are not aware of any marital debt. If any marital debt is discovered, it is the sole responsibility of the person who incurred the debt.
15. Each party is responsible for all the debts in their own names unless otherwise explained herein.

Provisions Relating to Attorney's Fees and Costs

16. The parties shall each pay their own attorney's fees and costs incurred in prosecuting this action.

Miscellaneous Provisions

17. Each party is ordered to execute and deliver to the other such documents as are required to implement the provisions of the Decree of Divorce entered by the Court.
