Based on the Parties' Joint Motion and Stipulation for Entry of Stipulated Judgment,

JUDGMENT IS HEREBY ENTERED in favor of Plaintiff Cornerstone Technologies, LLC

("Plaintiff") and against Defendants SolarCon HX, LLC ("SolarCon HX") and Attend SolarCon,

LLC ("Attend SolarCon") (collectively "SolarCon Defendants"), jointly and severally, as

follows:

1. Plaintiff is awarded judgment against SolarCon Defendants, jointly and severally, in the amount of \$27,163.55, which amount includes principal of \$21,416.01, accrued interest of

\$4,197.54 that will continue to accrue at 1.5% per month on the principal amount, late fees of \$50.00, and attorney's fees of \$1,500 as of May 15, 2026.

2. Attend SolarCon currently has pending a Proof of Claim against Freedom Forever, LLC in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware – Case No. 26-10522-BLS (“Freedom Forever Bankruptcy”). Attend SolarCon hereby irrevocably assigns to Plaintiff a first priority security interest in any and all disbursements, distributions, or other proceeds that Attend SolarCon receives or becomes entitled to receive from the Freedom Forever Bankruptcy, up to the full amount necessary to satisfy this Judgment, including all accrued interest, costs, and attorney's fees (the “Assigned Proceeds”). Attend SolarCon shall, within five (5) business days of receipt of any Assigned Proceeds, remit such funds directly to Plaintiff or Plaintiff's counsel. If the amount Attend SolarCon receives from the Freedom Forever Bankruptcy is insufficient to satisfy the full amount of this Judgment, the SolarCon Defendants remain jointly and severally liable for any and all remaining amounts owed.

3. This Judgment shall be augmented in the amount of interest that continues to accrue plus reasonable costs and attorney's fees expended in collecting said Judgment by execution or otherwise. Any augmentation or offset shall be established by declaration.

4. Plaintiff's claims against Defendant Jake Hess and Does 1 through 10 are hereby dismissed with prejudice, with each party to bear its own fees and costs as to those dismissed claims except as otherwise provided in this Judgment.
