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The above-captioned matter having come before the above-referenced Court, the Court having reviewed the file and finding the necessary pleadings in the file, the Court having entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and being otherwise fully advised states:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

Provisions Relating to Termination of Marriage

1. Amy and Jacob were married in Kingsburg, California, on June 11, 2016.
2. Amy is awarded a divorce on the grounds of irreconcilable differences and the marriage is hereby terminated.

Provisions Relating to Children

3. The parties have no minor children together and none are expected.

Provisions Relating to Alimony

4. Both parties are fully able to support themselves and neither of them shall be awarded alimony now or in the future.

Provisions Relating to Real Property

1. Amy purchased property pre marriage located at 220 Rennert Way, Dixon, CA 95620. This property was sold post separation, and all the proceeds are solely awarded to Amy. Jacob waives any claim to this property.
2. Amy purchased property post separation located at 6308 W. Lake Avenue South Jordan, UT 84009. This property was purchased and sold post separation, and all the proceeds are solely awarded to Amy. Jacob waives any claim to this property.
3. Jacob has or may purchase property in California. Any and all property purchased by Jacob post separation is his sole property and Amy will have no claim to it.

Provisions Relating to Personal Property

4. Both parties are awarded the property in their own possession free and clear of any claim by the other party. The parties separated in July 2018 and the property in their possession is the property they are to be awarded.
5. Both parties are solely responsible for any and all loans or liabilities, taxes, insurance, maintenance or repairs and all other costs associated with ownership of the vehicles they are being awarded as stated in the above paragraph.

6. Each party is awarded their own separate personal property that they acquired before their marriage.

7. All other personal property acquired during the marriage is awarded to the party who is in possession of the property as of the date of this agreement.

Provisions Relating to Financial and Investment Accounts

8. The parties have no known joint accounts. If any account is discovered in both parties names, the account is awarded to the party who set up the account and added the funds to the account.

9. Each party is awarded their own bank and/or financial accounts in their own name free and clear of any claim by the other party.

Provisions Relating to Retirement and Investment Accounts

10. The parties are awarded their own retirements and will have no claim to the retirement of the other party. This will include any and all investment accounts.

Provisions Relating to Debts

11. Each party is required to assume all responsibility for any debts in their name and hold the other party harmless therefrom.

12. Both parties are restrained from incurring any debts or obligations in the name of the other party.

13. The parties are unaware of any marital debt but if any is discovered the debt will be paid by the person who incurred the debt.

Provisions Relating to Attorney's Fees and Costs

14. Each party is required to pay their own attorney's fees and costs incurred in this matter.

Miscellaneous Provisions

15. Amy is allowed to change her name to Amy Louise Kuhn if she so desires.

16. Each party is ordered to execute and deliver to the other such documents as are required to implement the provisions of the Decree of Divorce entered by the Court.
