Petitioner: Jiaxing Wang (“Jiaxing” or “Husband”)

Respondent: Bodi Li (“Bodi” or “Wife”)

County of Residence: Salt Lake County, Utah

Minor Child/ren: None

The parties have stipulated to all terms related to their divorce, as evidenced by the Divorce Settlement Agreement filed with the Court. Based upon the parties’ agreement and the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law entered contemporaneously herewith, the Court **GRANTS** the Petition as set forth below, **DECREES** that the parties are divorced on the

grounds of irreconcilable differences and further **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Distribution of Assets.

- a. *Real Property.* The parties do not own real property. Husband shall be responsible for paying the lease payment at 320 N 490 W #2019, Salt Lake City, Utah and is entitled to occupy that property for the remainder of the lease or shall find a sublessor.
- b. *Vehicles.* Husband is awarded the vehicle in his name and possession, along with any associated debt or cost. Wife is awarded the 2021 Toyota Rav4, along with any associated debt or cost.
- c. *Financial Accounts.* The parties are awarded all accounts of any kind or nature in their own names, free and clear of any claims of the other. Wife is awarded the parties' joint account and shall close that account within 30 days.
- d. *Personal Property.* Each party is awarded his and her personal property, personal effects, and the like. Bodi shall be entitled return to the leased property within 60 days to retrieve her remaining personal property. If the parties disagree on how to divide any personal property purchased together, the property shall be sold, and the proceeds divided equally.

2. Distribution of Debts. The parties have no joint debt. All debts shall be the responsible of the party in whose name the debt exists, free and clear of any contribution of the other.

3. Alimony. Neither party is awarded alimony. All claims for alimony are waived.

4. Attorney's Fees. Husband shall pay the attorney's fees and costs that Wife has incurred to process this divorce.

5. Mediation Required. Should any dispute arise concerning anything related to the parties' marriage, the Divorce Settlement Agreement, or any resulting court orders, and the parties are unable to agree on a resolution, the parties shall attend mediation in good faith to attempt to resolve the dispute. If the dispute is not resolved by mediation, either party apply to the Court for a determination.
