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The Court, having reviewed the records, files, and papers in this matter, and having been fully advised, now ORDERS, ADJUDGES, and DECREES as follows:

The bonds of matrimony existing between Petitioner and Respondent are hereby dissolved. In addition, all other remaining issues in this matter, outlined below, are to become final and absolute upon entry by the Court.

JURISDICTION

1. Parties are residents of Salt Lake County, State of Utah and have been for at least three (3) months prior to the commencement of this action.

2. The parties were married on October 15, 2023, in Salt Lake City, Utah, and have since remained husband and wife.
3. The parties separated on November 15, 2025.
4. The parties have no minor children together.

GROUND FOR DIVORCE

5. During the course of the marriage, irreconcilable differences have arisen, making a continuance of the marriage impossible.

PERSONAL AND REAL PROPERTY

6. During the marriage, the parties acquired certain items of personal property. The parties' items of personal property shall be divided equitably between the parties within 30 days of entry of the Decree of Divorce. If they are unable to agree to an equitable division, they agree to attend mediation.
7. The parties shall continue to share their dog, Gordon, on a week on week off schedule. Meghan shall have primary legal ownership and final decision-making authority regarding Gordon's care. The parties shall equally share necessary veterinary expenses including costs due to illness, injury, and required medical treatment. Elective expenses include but are not limited to training, boarding, and non-essential procedures. Elective expenses shall be the responsibility of the party who incurred the cost unless otherwise agreed in writing. Meghan shall cover pet insurance. If this arrangement becomes untenable for any reason, such as distance between the parties or other

unforeseen circumstances, Gordon shall be awarded to Meghan for the payment of \$2,000 to Benjamin, free of any claim of Benjamin, along with all costs and responsibilities.

8. The parties shall be awarded the bank accounts in their respective names. Any joint bank accounts shall be closed no later than 14 days from entry of the Decree of Divorce after which the balances shall be equally divided.

9. The parties shall be awarded their own separate retirement accounts, free of any claim of the other. Both parties shall be removed as beneficiaries of one another's retirement accounts.

10. Benjamin shall be awarded the 2022 Toyota Tacoma and 1990 Suzuki Samurai, free of any claim of Meghan. Meghan shall be awarded the 2012 Suzuki SX4, free of any claim of Benjamin. Within 90 days of the Decree of Divorce, any loans on either vehicle shall be refinanced solely into the name of the party who is awarded the vehicle.

11. Benjamin shall be awarded exclusive possession to, title to, and equity in the real property located at 372 E Angel Ct. Sandy UT, 84070, free of any claim of Meghan. Benjamin shall pay Meghan \$16,000 from the equity in the home upon refinancing, selling, or assuming the loan within 180 days from the entry of the Decree of Divorce. Meghan shall quit claim her interest in the property to Benjamin no later than 14 days from entry of the Decree of

Divorce.

ALLOCATION OF MARITAL DEBTS¹². There is no marital debt to divide other than the mortgage as described above.

13. Notwithstanding the foregoing, each party shall be ordered to pay and assume, and hold the other harmless from, each and every debt he or she has incurred independent of the other party from the date of separation.

14. In accordance with the above allocation of debts, the parties shall hold each other harmless from the debts which have been allocated to him or her, and shall indemnify each other for any costs, charges or fees incurred as a result of a defense or claim made against the other for payment on those debts.

15. Both parties shall provide notice to their creditors, following entry of the decree of divorce, indicating who was ordered to pay which debts, and providing the creditor with the address of the party liable for that debt.

16. The expenses and debts which are ordered to pay, herein, shall be considered to be “in the nature of family support” for bankruptcy purposes.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS¹⁷. The parties shall maintain and pay for their own separate vehicle, dental, vision, and health insurance policies as of the date of the Decree of Divorce.

18. If either party must pursue legal action to receive timely and complete payment or reimbursement from the other party as required in the decree,

the party pursuing legal action shall be entitled to an award of attorney's fees and the delinquent payments or reimbursements shall be due with interest.

19. The parties shall be duly ordered to execute and deliver all documents necessary to effectuate the Decree of Divorce.
