Parent-time transfers

12. Pick-up and drop-off ("transfers") of the children for parent-time will be as described below:

The parties will make arrangements for pick up, delivery and return of the children prior to each scheduled parent-time.

Curbside transfers

13. There will not be curbside transfers. The parent/person dropping-off or picking-up a child may accompany the children to the other parent/person when parent-time transfers are made.

Decision-making

14. Each parent will make day-to-day decisions for the children during the time they are caring for the children. Either parent may make emergency decisions affecting the health or safety of the children. A parent who makes an emergency decision must share the decision with the other parent as soon as reasonably possible.

Sole decision-making.

15. Both Jamison Paul Lewis and Dawn Eby Lewis will make decisions about education together.

16. Both Jamison Paul Lewis and Dawn Eby Lewis will make decisions about health care together.

17. Both Jamison Paul Lewis and Dawn Eby Lewis will make decisions about religion together.

Education plan

18. The school the children will attend is based on a specific plan for where the children will attend school: **Determined by signed agreement between Jamison Paul Lewis and Dawn Eby Lewis.**

19. Jamison Paul Lewis and Dawn Eby Lewis has authority to check the children out of school. Jamison Paul Lewis and Dawn Eby Lewis has access to the children during school. If the parents cannot agree, education decisions will be made by Jamison Paul Lewis.

Communication with the children

21. The parents agree they will:

- provide age-appropriate help to the children to communicate with the other parent.
- give the children privacy during their communication with the other parent. The parents will not interfere with or monitor communication between the children and the other parent.

22. Parents and children may communicate with each other whenever the children choose.

- By telephone
Parents will maintain voice mail so the children can leave and receive messages.
- By text
- By letter
- By email

Records and information sharing

23. Both parents will have access to records and the ability to consult with providers regarding education, child care, and health care.

Travel by the children

24. During their parent-time, the parent may consent for the children to travel with a sports team, religious group, school group, relatives, friends, by themselves, or with others.

25. If the children will be travelling for more than **3** days, the parent arranging the travel will notify the other parent at least **15** days in advance. That parent will give the other parent the travel schedule, locations and phone numbers at least **7** days in advance. In case of emergency, the parent will provide as much notice as possible.

Child care

26. A child care provider for our children must be:

- A licensed child care provider.
- A relative, friend, or neighbor.
- Over the age of **16**.

Relocation of a parent

27. Neither parent may relocate with the minor children more than **120** miles from their current residence without a written agreement signed by the parties or further court order.

28. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other or the parents live in separate countries, costs for the children's travel expenses for parent-time will be shared

equally.

29. If a parent has been found in contempt for not being current on all support obligations, and they do not have primary physical care of the child, they will be responsible for the child's related travel expenses.

30. Reimbursement for the child's travel expenses must be made within 30 days of receipt of documents detailing those expenses.

Resolving disputes

31. If the parents need to resolve a dispute regarding the children, they will discuss the issues in good faith and try to reach an agreement based on what is best for their children. If the parents are unable to agree, they will go to the following before bringing the issue to the court:

a. Mediation

Changing the plan

This plan remains in effect until changed. A change comes from a modification of a court order.

32. A joint physical custody arrangement may result in denial of cash assistance under the Employment Support Act, Title 35A, Chapter 3, of the Utah Code.

33. **Jamison Paul Lewis's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$6005**. **Jamison Paul Lewis** receives the following gross monthly income:

34. **Dawn Eby Lewis's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$4000**. **Dawn Eby Lewis** receives the following gross monthly income:

35. The adjusted gross monthly income for **Dawn Eby Lewis** is **\$4000**.

Child support (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2)

36. It is in the best interest of the children that **Jamison Paul Lewis** be ordered to pay child support to **Dawn Eby Lewis** as follows:

a. **\$112.00** per month base support. This amount complies with the Utah Child Support Act.

37. Once a child is no longer eligible to receive child support, the support amount for the eligible children should be recalculated using the child support worksheet (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2). The parties may not divide the base child support award by the number of children and subtract that amount from the prior child support amount.

38. The **joint** custody worksheet was used to calculate child support.

39. The base child support amount using the joint custody calculation is **\$112** per month.

Child support reduction for extended parent-time

40. If a child lives with the non-custodial parent by court order or written agreement of the parties for:

- 25 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 50% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(a)).
- 12 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 25% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(b)).

The custodial parent's normal parent-time and holiday parent-time do not count as an interruption of the consecutive day requirement.

41. If a child receives cash assistance through the T.A.N.F. or F.E.P. programs, any agreement by the parties to reduce child support during extended parent-time must be approved by the Office of Recovery Services.

42. **Dawn Eby Lewis** will give **Jamison Paul Lewis** the information needed to set up direct deposit through **Jamison Paul Lewis's** employer. Once **Jamison Paul Lewis** has the information, **Jamison Paul Lewis** will have **Jamison Paul Lewis's** employer set up direct deposit to an account of **Dawn Eby Lewis's** choice. One half of the child support is due by the 5th of each month, and the other half is due by the 20th of each month.

43. The issue of past-due child support may be decided by future court or administrative action.

44. **Jamison Paul Lewis** and **Dawn Eby Lewis** will each pay half of any ORS fee.

- a. If a fee is withheld from payments to **Dawn Eby Lewis**, **Jamison Paul Lewis** will reimburse **Dawn Eby Lewis** for half the fee.

45. The parties must notify each other within 30 days of any change in their income.

46. The Office of Recovery Services (<https://ors.utah.gov/>) provides services to individuals who are seeking assistance in the collection or enforcement of child support orders.

Dependent children for tax purposes

47. The parents may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes as follows:

48. **Jamison Paul Lewis** may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes in odd numbered years. **Dawn Eby Lewis** may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes in even numbered years.

Child health care (Utah Code 81-6-208)

49. The parties must provide health care coverage for the medical expenses of the dependent children. Health care coverage means coverage under which medical services

are provided to a dependent child through: fee for service, a health maintenance organization, a preferred provider organization, any other type of private health insurance, or public health care coverage. Utah Code 81-6-101(14),

50. Both parents must maintain medical, hospital, and dental care insurance for the dependent children if it is available at reasonable cost. If medical insurance is not available at reasonable cost then both parents must ensure the children have health care coverage. This may require applying for public health care coverage, such as CHIP or Medicaid.

a. If, at any time, a dependent child is covered by the medical, hospital, or dental insurance plans of both parents, the coverage will be as follows:

- **Jamison Paul Lewis's** insurance will be primary coverage.
- **Dawn Eby Lewis's** insurance will be secondary coverage.

b. If a parent remarries and that parent's dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a step-parent's plan, the coverage will be as follows:

- **Jamison Paul Lewis's** spouse's insurance will be primary coverage.
- **Dawn Eby Lewis's** spouse's insurance will be secondary coverage.

c. Both parties will equally share the out-of-pocket costs of the insurance premiums.

d. Both parties will equally share all uninsured and unreimbursed medical and dental expenses that are reasonable and necessary. This includes deductibles, co-insurance, and co-payments paid by a party for the dependent children.

e. The party who pays health care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and payment within 30 days.

f. If a party does not follow this order and provide written verification, they may not be able to receive credit for health care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.

g. On or before January 2 of each year, the party ordered to maintain coverage must provide verification of coverage to the other party, and ORS, if they are involved.

h. If there is any change in coverage, within 30 days of the change the party ordered to maintain coverage must notify the other party and ORS, if they are involved.

Child care expenses (Utah Code 81-6-209)

51. Both parties will equally share all reasonable work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses.

a. The party who pays child care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and identity of the child care provider. This must be done when a provider is first hired, and any time the other party asks for the information. The party incurring or paying child care expenses must notify the other party of any change of a child care provider or monthly expense. This must be done within 30 calendar days of the change.

b. The party not directly paying for child care must pay their share of child care

expenses as soon as they receive verification of the expenses.

c. If a party does **not** follow the order and provide written verification, they may not receive credit for work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.
