Paul Thomas Erspamer (hereinafter “”) has submitted an Affidavit as to residency and grounds for divorce and Notice to Submit for Decision. The Court finds that Majra Hindic (hereinafter “Majra”) has accepted service, appeared, consented to default and waived the 30 day waiting period, in writing. Having made findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Court now orders and decrees the following:

1. The bonds of matrimony and marriage contract between the parties are dissolved, and Paul Thomas Erspamer is awarded a Decree of Divorce from Majra Hindic, to become final upon entry by the Court.
1. Alimony
2. Each party is capable of supporting themselves. Therefore, no alimony is awarded.
2. Debts
3. Paul is ordered to pay and assume the following debts: All debts in his name. Paul shall hold Majra harmless from any liability on these debts.
4. Majra is ordered to pay and assume the following debts: All debts in her name. Majra

shall hold Paul harmless from any liability on these debts.

5. Each party is ordered to pay and assume her and his own debts incurred after the parties' separation in March 2026. Each party shall hold the other party harmless from any liability on these debts.

6. Each party is ordered to notify respective creditors regarding the court's division of debts and liabilities and regarding the parties' separate current addresses.

3. Personal Property

7. The personal property shall be divided equitably.

Real Estate

8. The parties acquired real property during their marriage located at: 1277 N Providence Way, Tooele, Utah. The home is titled in Paul's name only and he is the only one liable for the mortgage. Paul is awarded all right, title and interest in the property free from any claim by Majra.

9. Each party is awarded their own pension or retirement benefits accrued during the marriage.

10. Each party is ordered to execute and deliver to the other party documents necessary to implement the provisions of the Decree of Divorce entered by the Court.
