Divorce

Duty to sign documents

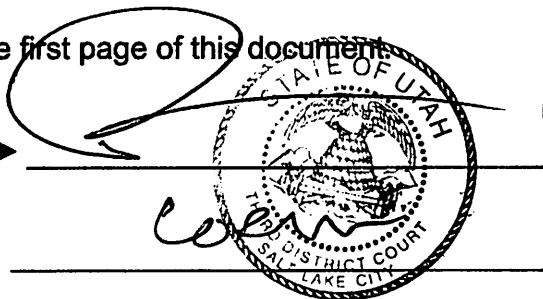
