ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

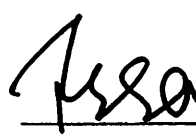
That the Petitioner is awarded a Decree of Divorce from the Respondent, to become final upon signature and entry.

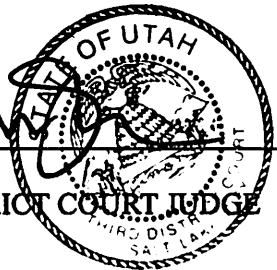
1. During the course of the marriage, the parties did not acquire any personal property subject to division.
2. During the course of the marriage, the parties did not acquire any marital debts; therefore, no division of debts is necessary.
3. During the course of the marriage, the parties did not acquire any real property; therefore, no division of real property is necessary.

4. Neither party should be awarded alimony from the other.
5. Neither party has any interest in retirement programs, pensions, or profit-sharing plans subject to division; therefore, no further distribution is necessary.
6. During the marriage, the parties did not have or adopt any minor children.
7. Both parties should be ordered to sign and fully execute whatever documents are necessary for the implementation of the provisions of this divorce decree. Should a party fail to execute a document within 60 days of the entry of this divorce decree, the other party may bring an Order to Show Cause at the expense of the disobedient party and seek that the Court appoint some other person to execute the document pursuant to Rule 70 of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure. Any document executed pursuant to Rule 70 has the same effect as if executed by the disobedient party.
9. Prior to any Petition being filed to change any provision of the final Decree of Divorce, the parties must attempt to resolve the issue through mediation.
10. The Court should grant such other and further relief as it may deem just and appropriate in this matter.

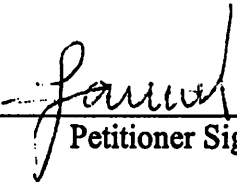
