RENEWED JUDGMENT

The plaintiffs' motion to renew judgment was heard in this court on May 27, 2025, at 10:30 a.m. The Honorable Kevin R. Anderson presided. Ryan R. Bolander appeared on behalf of the plaintiffs. The defendant did not appear.

The Court being fully apprised, having found that the elements of Utah Code Ann. § 78B-6-1802 have been satisfied, having reviewed the *Declaration in Support of Motion to Renew Judgment* (ECF No. 27), which contains the accounting required by Utah law, for good cause appearing, and for the reasons stated in open court at the May 27 hearing, the Court entered its *Order Approving Motion to Renew Judgment* (ECF No. 35), granting the Plaintiffs' *Motion to Renew Judgment*. Based on the entry of that order, the Court hereby ENTERS RENEWED JUDGMENT of \$248,190.89 in favor of the plaintiffs and against the defendant.

Wherefore, the defendant should pay to the plaintiffs a sum of \$248,190.89, which debt is not discharged by the discharge otherwise granted by the bankruptcy proceedings, together with post-judgment interest thereon at the statutory rate until paid in full.

Pursuant to Utah R. Civ. P. 58C, the original judgment is renewed from May 1, 2025. Pursuant to Utah R. Civ. P. 58C and Utah Code Ann. § 78B-6-1804, this judgment shall continue for eight years from the date of entry of this order, unless otherwise satisfied, and may be renewed upon motion to the Court.
