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The Court, having previously authorized an award of attorney's fees and directed counsel to submit an affidavit of fees, and Petitioner, Taylor Hause, having filed an Affidavit of Attorney's Fees, through counsel of record, on June 8, 2026, and no objection having been filed by Respondent, Tayler Cordova, within fourteen (14) days, hereby enters the following:

FINDINGS

1. At the hearing on Petitioner's Motion to Enforce, the Court determined that Petitioner is entitled to an award of reasonable attorney's fees and costs and directed counsel to submit an Affidavit of Attorney's Fees setting forth the amount incurred.
2. Petitioner filed an Affidavit of Attorney's Fees on June 8, 2026, together with Exhibit A detailing the attorney's fees and costs incurred in connection with the Motion to Enforce.

3. The Affidavit was properly served upon Respondent.
4. The Court has reviewed the Affidavit and Exhibit A and finds that the attorney's fees and costs incurred in connection with the Motion to Enforce were reasonable and necessary.
5. The Court finds Petitioner incurred attorney's fees and costs totaling \$6,400.00 in connection with the Motion to Enforce.
6. The Court further finds that, in light of the relief obtained, an award of one-half of the fees and costs incurred, totaling \$3,200.00, is reasonable and appropriate.
7. Accordingly, the Court finds that Petitioner should be awarded attorney's fees and costs in the amount of \$3,200.00.

ORDERS

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Award of Fees. Respondent shall pay Petitioner attorney's fees in the amount of \$3,200.00.
2. Judgement. This amount is reduced to judgment in favor of Petitioner and against Respondent in the amount of \$3,200.00, which shall accrue interest at the statutory rate until paid.
