Pursuant to Rule 55(b)(1) of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court hereby enters Judgment in favor of Plaintiff ODK CAPITAL, LLC, against Defendants RR PROJECTS & DESIGN, LLC and MARK RUSSELL, jointly and severally, in the principal amount of \$82,061.56, plus pre-judgment interest at the statutory rate of 10% per annum, pursuant to Utah Code § 15-1-1, from July 18, 2025 through March 27, 2026 in the amount of \$5,665.62, attorneys fees in the amount of \$350.00, pursuant to URCP 73(f)(1), as the underlying agreement between the Parties provides for attorneys' fees in the event of default, and in compliance with Rule of Professional Conduct 5.4, for a total judgment of \$88,077.18, plus post-judgment interest at the legal rate of 5.51% from the date of judgment until paid, based on the following:

1. Defendants RR PROJECTS & DESIGN, LLC and MARK RUSSELL have failed to appear or otherwise defend in this case;
2. Defendants have been served pursuant to Rule 4(d)(1).

It is further ordered that this judgment MAY be augmented in the amount of post-judgment interest at the legal rate of 5.51%, and reasonable costs and attorneys' fees expended in substantial efforts in collecting said judgment by execution or otherwise as shall be established by affidavit, permitted by rule and/or the law, and approved by the Court.

Defendants RR PROJECTS & DESIGN, LLC and MARK RUSSELL are jointly and severally liable for this judgment.
