This matter came before the Honorable Commissioner Blomquist, at a hearing on April 28, 2026. Petitioner was present and was represented by her attorney, Heather Comeau Rupp, who was present. Respondent was present and was represented by his attorney, Nima Kian, who was present and representing Mr. Richards on a limited scope basis. The matter was before the Court on the Petitioner's Motion to Enforce.

The Court, having reviewed the parties' pleadings and hearing argument and proffer of counsel, hereby ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES:

1. A judgment shall enter in the amount of \$10,500 for child support arrears with post-judgment interest at the 5.51% per annum pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §15-1-4. This is the unpaid amount from November 1, 2024 to April 30, 2025 at the rate of \$1,750 per month, when the parties had two minor children.
