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The above-captioned matter having come before the above-referenced Court upon the Stipulated Petition for Annulment, the Court having reviewed the file and the necessary pleadings in the file, and the Court having entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and being otherwise fully advised, states:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

Provisions Relating to Jurisdiction

1. Petitioner is an actual and bona fide resident of Salt Lake County, State of Utah, and has been for more than three months immediately prior to the commencement of this action.

2. Silvia Hernandez and Silvestre Cruz were married in Salt Lake County, Utah on November 13, 2011.

Provisions Relating to Grounds for Annulment

3. Silvestre Cruz was already married to Maria Del Refugio Bugarin at the time of the marriage between the parties in the present matter.

4. Accordingly, the marriage between Silvia Hernandez and Silvestre Cruz is void as a bigamous marriage.

Provisions Related to Termination of Marriage

5. The marriage between the parties is hereby annulled and terminated as if it never existed.

Provisions Relating to Children

6. The parties have no minor children together.

Provisions Relating to Alimony

7. Neither party should be awarded any alimony now or in the future.

Provisions Relating to Real Property

8. The parties have no real property that is marital.

Provisions Relating to Personal Property

9. The parties should each be awarded all of the personal property in their current possession free and clear of any claim by the other party.

Provisions Relating to Financial and Investment Accounts

10. Each party should be granted any and all financial, bank, or investment accounts of any kind in their own name free and clear of any claim by the other party.

Provisions Relating to Retirement

11. Both parties should be awarded any and all retirement accounts, plans, or assets in their own name free and clear of any claim by the other party.

Provisions Relating to Debts

12. The parties should be solely responsible for any and all debt that is associated with their own name and hold the other party harmless and indemnify the other party of such debts.
13. There are no debts in both parties' names.

Miscellaneous Provisions

14. As part of this agreement, Silvestre Cruz will make a one-time payment of \$500 to Silvia Hernandez in order to reimburse the costs she paid including the filing fee and constable fee that she paid to file and serve her petition that started these proceedings.
 - a. This payment shall in no way be construed as bribe or compensation for signing but rather a reimbursement made voluntarily and knowing full well that in the absence of this agreement Silvia could proceed in her efforts to obtain a divorce, alimony, or different order on any other terms. She waives that right and

wishes to simply have the marriage annulled after being reimbursed for her costs
in the amount of \$500.
