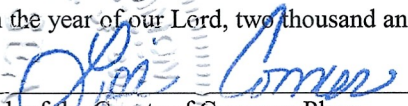

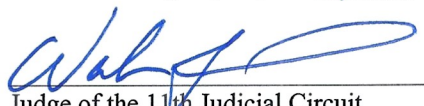

The Plaintiff has filed a Motion for Default Judgment. Based on the motion and accompanying Affidavit of Default, Affidavits of Service, payment history, and Attorney Fee Affidavit, and it appearing that the damages sought in this action are liquidated, and that more than ten (10) days have passed since the Plaintiff sent notice of default to the Defendants, it is

ORDERED that the Plaintiff have judgment against the Defendants, jointly and severally, in the amount of \$93,707.08, calculated as follows:

- (a) As to Account No. 9044, the sum of \$32,701.62, plus interest in the amount of \$13,081.43 (\$16.13 per day from September 15, 2023, to December 5, 2025);
- (b) As to Account No. 5226, the sum of \$33,398.89, plus interest in the amount of \$12,583.08 (\$16.47 per day from November 1, 2023, to December 5, 2025);
- (c) Attorney's fees and costs in the amount of \$1,942.06.

plus interest at the statutory rate from the date of this order until paid in full; and
