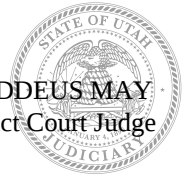

Pursuant to Utah R. Civ. P. 58A(f) and Utah Code § 78B-5-205, and based on the parties' *Stipulation and Confession for Entry of Judgment Against Defendant Aaron Angle* on file with the Court, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Plaintiff Freedom Solar Pros, LLC, is awarded judgment against Defendant Aaron Angle in the amount of **\$39,363.06**, calculated as follows:

Amount received	\$37,500.00
Less credits/payments made	(\$1,929.14)
Plus pre-judgment interest at the rate of 10% per annum pursuant to the parties' contract from March 8, 2025 through March 31, 2026	\$ 3,792.20
Total Judgment	\$39,363.06

The Court notes that, although the confessed amount was \$50,000.00, Defendant is obligated to pay only the amount actually received, which is \$37,500.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this judgment may be augmented by the reasonable costs and attorney fees expended in collecting this judgment, whether by execution or otherwise, as established by affidavit and approved by the Court.
