The Court having reviewed the file and for good cause appearing, having previously entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law now hereby:

ORDERS ADJUDGES AND DECREES

1. The parties' marital relationship is dissolved. The parties are hereby divorced on the grounds of irreconcilable differences.

JURISDICTION, VENUE AND GROUNDS

2. Petr is a resident of Salt Lake County, Utah.
3. Angela is a resident of Twin Falls County, Idaho.
4. The parties agree the State of Utah, Salt Lak County, have jurisdiction in his matter, and Salt Lake County is the appropriate venue.
5. The parties were married July 18, 2009, and are presently married.
6. There are two children born of the marriage: A.P.K., August 2012, and M.P.K.,

born March 2017.

Custody

7. The parties will share joint legal custody and Petr will have final say.

Parent-time

8. Petr will have sole physical custody, and Angela will have parent-time according to the relocation statute, Utah Code Annotated (“UCA”) 81-9-209.

9. Angela shall have the second weekend of the month as her weekend.

- a. If a holiday, as outlined in UCA 81-9-302, falls on a Monday that is next to her weekend, she gets to exercise parent-time for that holiday as well. She also has Mother’s Day.

- b. In years ending in an odd number, the minor child shall spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent: (A) fall break if the minor child's school dismisses for a fall break, beginning on the day that school dismisses for fall break and ending on the day before school resumes; or (B) Labor Day if the minor child's school does not dismiss for a fall break, beginning on the day that school dismisses for Labor Day and ending on the day before school resumes; and the entire winter break period, beginning on the day that school dismisses for the winter break and ending on the day before school resumes.

- c. In years ending in an even number, the minor child shall spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent: spring break, beginning on the day that school dismisses for the spring break and ending on the day

before school resumes; or Presidents' Day if the minor child's school does not dismiss for a spring break, beginning on the day that school dismisses for Presidents' Day and ending on the day before school resumes; and Thanksgiving, beginning on the day that school dismisses for Thanksgiving and ending on the day before school resumes.

10. Angela shall be responsible for travel arrangements, as outlined in UCA 81-9-209, and shall be present for all drop-off's or pick-up's when she gets the children.

- a. Petr, as outlined in UCA 8-9-209, will be responsible for half of the summer travel.
- b. Petr will be responsible for taking the children to Tremonton for the monthly weekend Friday drop-off, for holidays, and Mother's Day. The parties will exchange between 9:00 and 9:30 pm. Angela will take the children from Tremonton to her home and will be responsible for the entire Sunday return trip.
- c. Angela will be present at the exchanges, unless the person picking up is someone she has had a relationship with for at least 12 months and is known to the children.
- d. Petr will do the drop-off until Angela's off of probation, and then the parties will revisit the matter.

11. If Angela moves within 30 minutes of Petr, the parties will attend mediation to determine a new parent-time arrangement.

12. Angela must keep the terms of her probation, anticipated to end March 2028. If

she breaks probation, Petr can take the kids back.

13. Summer Parent-Time 2026: The parties shall do every other week, starting June 28th. Mom has parent time: June 28th through July 5th; July 10th through July 19th; and July 26th through August 2nd. Dad will transport on June 28th and July 26th. Mom will transport on July 5th, July 19th, and August 2nd. Angela's parents will transport on July 10th.

Communication

14. The parties will communicate in writing, unless it is an emergency. They will respond to one another within 24 hours of the last communication sent in any given day, or as reasonable.

Dispute Resolution

15. If a disagreement arises, and the parties are unable to agree, they shall: 1) discuss the matter, 2) if they are still unable to agree they will consult with a specialist or expert on the matter, such as the family doctor for medical issues, 3) if they are still unable to agree Petr will have final say, subject to Angela's right to take the matter to mediation, 4) if they cannot agree at mediation, the parties may take the matter before the court.

Child Support

16. The parties will do child support pursuant to UCA 81-6-212.

17. The parties agree Petr makes \$13,995 a month. The parties agree Angela makes \$0 a month. Under a sole custody calculation, Angela shall pay child support to Petr of \$30 a month.

Alimony

18. Both parties agree that neither is entitled to alimony, and both parties wave alimony now and forever from this divorce.

Home

19. There is a home at 5788 S. 1145 E., Murray, Utah.

20. The parties agree Petr shall be given sole possession of the home.

21. Petr shall have 90 days, if necessary, to get Angela's name off the mortgage.

22. Angela shall have 30 days to sign a quitclaim, if necessary, to get her name off the title.

Payout

23. Petr shall pay Angela \$80,000 as a complete and total payout for her share of any marital equity, including the home, the business, and any personal property.

24. Petr shall pay that to Angela in payments of \$1,500 a month for 11 months, with a lump sum payment due on the 12th month. He shall make his first payment starting July 1, 2026.

Taxes

25. Petr shall claim the children on his taxes, but this will be revisited with a change to child support or parent-time.

26. Petr will be responsible for all tax liability from the marriage.

Business

27. Petr shall get the business, Renovation Brothers, free and clear of any claim by Angela. Petr will hold her harmless from any debts or liabilities of the business

Property

28. The parties have already divided out all retirement accounts, bank accounts, and all personal property.

Additional Items

29. **Sharing of Information:** Both parents shall be provided complete access to all records of the child. The parents shall share with each information on the child's development, education, healthcare, church, extracurricular, and other activities.

30. **Decision-Making:** Each parent shall have the right to make day-to-day decisions concerning the child while he or she is in the care of that parent. For all other decisions regarding the child, the parents shall cooperate and work together to make joint decisions that are in the best interest of their child.

31. Telephone Contact and Virtual Access:

- a. Telephone contact shall be at reasonable hours and for a reasonable duration.
- b. The parties will notify each other within 24 hours of any change in cell phone number, email address, or other virtual parent-time access.
- c. Each parent shall permit and encourage, during reasonable hours, reasonable and uncensored communications with the child in the form of mail, email, and virtual parent-time. Each parent will take reasonable steps to facilitate the children having telephone and virtual contact with the other parent.

32. Health and Dental Insurance:

- a. Petr shall be the primary for purposes of health and dental insurance for the children.
- b. In the event that Petr obtains insurance, and Angela does not have the children covered, Angela shall compensate Petr for one-half the cost of the minor children's premium. In the event that both parties have medical coverage for the minor children, each party shall pay their own cost and neither party shall compensate the other.
- c. Pursuant to 81-6-208 the parties shall:
 - 1. provide health care coverage for the medical expenses of a child;
 - 2. provide insurance for the medical expenses of a child if insurance is available to the parents at a reasonable cost; in accordance with Subsection 81-6-206, Petr shall maintain primary medical insurance on behalf of the minor children so long as it remains available to him at his place of employment at a reasonable expense. Angela shall maintain secondary medical insurance on behalf of the minor children so long as it remains available to her at her place of employment at a reasonable expense. If a parent remarries and his or her dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a step-parent's plan, the health, hospital, or dental insurance plan of the step-parent shall be treated as if it is the plan of the remarried parent and shall retain the same designation as the primary or secondary plan of the dependent child. The parties shall share equally the out-of-pocket costs of the premium actually paid by a parent for the child's portion of insurance; and equally share all reasonable and necessary uninsured and

unreimbursed medical and dental expenses incurred for a child, including co-payments, co-insurance, and deductibles.

Disclosures and Drafting

33. Attorney's Fees and Costs: Each party shall be ordered to assume his or her own costs and attorney's fees incurred in this action.
