AND JUDGMENT**

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**THIS MATTER** came before the Court on June 24, 2026 on Petitioner's Motion to Enforce and on Respondent's Counter Motion to Enforce. The Petitioner was present and appeared with her counsel, Darin S. Featherstone, via Webex. The Respondent was also present and appeared with his counsel, Alex Scherf.

**THE COURT**, having reviewed the documents submitted on behalf of the parties; having heard proffers and arguments from counsel; being fully informed in the premises; and for good cause appearing;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that:

1. Judgment is entered against the Respondent and in favor of the Petitioner in the amount of \$57,686.76, for child support and other support arrears from January 2023 through June 2026 (plus any and all collection costs or fees incurred hereafter related to collecting on this judgment), all of which is deemed to be in the nature of child support.
2. Post-judgment interest at the current legal rate shall be applied to said judgment.
3. The Respondent shall pay his monthly child support and health insurance premium payments (in-full) from this time forward in the current amount of \$3,719.21 per month.
4. In addition, the Respondent will pay \$500 per month toward the above-listed Judgment for a total monthly payment of \$4,219.21.
5. If the Respondent is more than 30-days delinquent on his monthly payment (or partially delinquent on his monthly payment) then the Petitioner may initiate collection efforts to collect the entire sum.
6. In addition, the issues of contempt, sanctions, jail time, and attorney fees and costs is reserved for a review hearing, if necessary.
7. If the Respondent's fails to follow this order (by becoming delinquent or partially delinquent on his monthly payments as listed above), then the Court will consider holding him in contempt, sanctions, jail time (if necessary), and an award for attorney fees and costs.
8. The Respondent shall immediately change his life insurance policy so that the Petitioner is the "owner" of the policy and provide the Petitioner with verification documentation that he has done so.
