The matter before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion to Renew Judgment (the "Motion").

The Court finds:

1. This Court originally entered a judgment in this case on June 4, 2010 in the amount of \$1,472.70 (the "Original Judgment") and renewed said judgment by that certain Renewal Judgment entered on December 19, 2018 in the amount of \$2,749.79 (the "Renewal Judgment").
2. The Motion was filed before the statute of limitations on the Original Judgment, as renewed by the Renewal Judgment, expired.
