Petitioner Ronald Guillermo Uzcategui Zerpa, by and through his counsel, Todd Weiler of Christensen & Jensen, P.C., having been filed and served on Respondent, Anders Nielsen on April 9, 2026; Respondent having failed to answer or otherwise plead within the time permitted, and Petitioner having filed all of the appropriate and necessary pleadings. Petitioner's Declarations and the pleadings on file herein, and having established jurisdiction, and the court having previously entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, based thereon and for good cause appearing therefore. The Court, being fully advised, hereby ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES as follows:

1. The parties to this action were married virtually on July 12, 2024 in Salt Lake City, Utah.

2. During the marital relationship the parties have not resided in the State of Utah. This court has jurisdiction over both parties and the marriage pursuant to Utah Code § 81-4-402(1)(c) and § 81-2-303(5)(a).

3. Irreconcilable differences have arisen between the parties which has made

4. No minor children are at issue of this marriage.

5. Both parties to this action are able bodied, and neither party is awarded any alimony from the other.

6. The parties have acquired certain items of personal effects, clothing and belongings. Each party shall be awarded their own such items and all items acquired during the marriage shall be divided between the parties in a fair and equitable fashion.

7. The parties have acquired various items of furniture, fixtures, appliances and household goods. Each party shall be awarded any and all pre-marital property and the personal property acquired during the marriage shall be divided between the parties in a fair and equitable fashion.

8. The parties do not own any real property.

9. The parties have incurred various debts and obligations. Each party shall pay and assume all debts and obligations incurred in his or her own name subsequent to the date of separation of the parties.

10. Each party shall pay his or her own attorney fees and court costs incurred.

11. Each party shall be ordered to execute and deliver any necessary documents to transfer the title and ownership of the property of the parties pursuant to the decree entered in this matter.

12. Any and all property and money received or retained by either party pursuant to the divorce shall be deemed the separate property of such party free and clear of any right, interest or claim of the other party, including the right to inherit or to be named as a beneficiary except as specifically awarded therein, and each party shall have the right hereafter to use and enjoy, independently of any claim or right of the other party, all items of real or personal property awarded to them.
